Background/policy:

The Cal-Learn Program serves welfare recipients under 19 years old who are custodial parents or pregnant. To encourage these teen parents to stay in or return to high school or an equivalent program and earn a diploma or its equivalent, the Cal-Learn Program provides fiscal incentives and disincentives as well as needed supportive services and intensive case management.

The major program requirements of the Cal-Learn Program are as follows:

Each teen parent will be required to attend full-time school programs that will lead to a high school diploma or equivalent until he or she earns a high school diploma or its equivalent or turns 19 years old.

LRS functionality:

Topic

When a CalWORKs EDBC is run and the program is approved, the LRS system automatically determines whether the applicant is a mandatory Cal-Learn participant, based on information entered by the EW during the CalWORKs interview.

Cal-Learn is mandatory for anyone in the CalWORKs household who meets all of the following requirements:

- Under 19 years old
- No high school diploma or equivalent
- Pregnant or parenting
- CalWORKs status is Active

The LRS system creates an Automated Program Action section for Cal-Learn on the CalWORKs EDBC Results page for each applicant who meets the criteria listed above.

The LRS system assigns a status of Pending to the automatically created Cal-Learn program.

During a nightly batch run, the Cal-Learn Program is assigned to the appropriate Adolescent Family Life Program (AFLP) agency, based on the zip codes that each AFLP office handles.
