Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	<b>Purpose</b> This CIT affects the 40 LRS and C-IV Counties. The purpose of this CIT is to inform the C-IV and LRS Counties that per direction from the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), the SAWS systems are to no longer enforce Semi-Annual Reporting (SAR) and Re-determination (RE)/Re-certifications (RC) requirements. Cases that were targeted to be discontinued effective April 1, 2020, and ongoing for an undetermined number of months, due to not submitting or completing the re- determination, re-certification or SAR process will <b>NOT</b> be discontinued.
	<b>Background</b> CDSS has approved suspending automated system (batch) processing of SAR and RE/RC for the CalWORKs (CW) and CalFresh (CF) programs. This was done to allow for ongoing benefits during the <u>COVID-19 emergency following the Governor's</u> <u>Executive Order</u> .
	This means: • C-IV/LRS will continue to issue benefits even if the RE/RC or SAR is missing or incomplete.

	<ul> <li>C-IV/LRS will not discontinue programs for incomplete or missing RE/RCs or SARs for CW/CF.</li> <li>Counties should expect increased issuance amounts for main payroll.</li> <li>The project expects an 6-8% increase in the total amount issued by each county and an 3-6% increase in warrants.</li> <li>Historically, a small amount of prior month issuances, which have been skipping, will be released as part of this change.</li> <li>This change will be made prior to the following main payroll runs:         <ul> <li>Los Angeles: 3/20</li> <li>C-IV Counties (except Riverside): 3/26</li> <li>Riverside County: 3/27</li> </ul> </li> </ul>			
	Additional Information The automation efforts to resume the suspended process discussed in this CIT are still being discussed with CDSS. As information becomes available, the Project will send updates to the counties.			
	<ol> <li>IMPORTANT NOTE: If a Worker runs an individual EDBC for CW or CF, the Systems rules will run and the Worker may need to override the EDBC in order to prevent a discontinuance or benefit reduction specific to the RE or SAR determination.</li> <li>Inform the County Auditor Controller/Treasurer of increased Main Payroll amount.</li> <li>Confirm that the county has enough warrant stock, envelopes, and postage.</li> <li>Communicate to staff that no changes, which originated because of a SAR, RE or RC, should result in a benefit reduction or a discontinuance.</li> </ol>
