<p>Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)</p>	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to inform the LRS and C-IV Counties that SCR CA-215728/CIV-107072 was implemented on April 30, 2020 to address individuals who have exhausted their TANF time limit, but who are eligible for CW under a State-funded aid code. CalWORKs (CW) 48-Month and Welfare-to-Work (WTW) 24-Month Time Clocks received the Lack of Supportive Services good cause exemption for March, April, May, and June 2020 benefit months.</p> <p>Background In response to ACWDL (March 27, 2020), the CW 48-Month and WTW 24-Month Time Clocks should not tick and CW recipients should be identified as exempt under the Lack of Supportive Services good cause exemption reason code 407.</p> <p>Additional Information SCRs CA-215728/C-IV-107072 implemented the following changes for individuals who have exhausted their TANF time limit, but who are eligible for CW under a State-funded aid code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Automatically applied the Lack of Supportive Services good cause exemption reason to the applicable cases • Added a journal entry to document the updates made to the cases
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	<p>The Lack of Supportive Services good cause exemption applies to individuals who had time remaining on their CW 48-Month Time Clock as of March 2020 and who did not have an existing clock-stopping exemption or extender.</p> <p>CIT 005-21 addresses additional effort for this good cause exemption as a response to COVID-19 under SCR CA-214490/CIV-106721.</p> <p>County Action No county action required. Individuals who exhausted their TANF time on aid are transitioned to State-funded aid codes if eligible.</p>
