- SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF DELAYING ANNUAL REDETERMINATIONS, DISCONTINUANCES, AND NEGATIVE ACTIONS DUE TO COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

The purpose of this Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter (MEDIL) is to instruct counties to extend the delay of processing Medi-Cal annual redeterminations and delay discontinuances and negative actions for Medi-Cal, Medi-Cal Access Program (MCAP), Medi-Cal Access Infant Program (MCAIP), and County Children's Health Initiative Program (CCHIP) through the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE).

Previously, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) released <u>MEDIL I 20-07</u> that instructed the delay to be effective for 90 days from the date of the MEDIL. DHCS is extending the timeframe through the end of the PHE.

Counties may continue to terminate cases for the following:

- Individuals who are reported to be deceased,
- Individuals who are no longer a resident of the state, or
- Individuals who request voluntary discontinuance from Medi-Cal.
