

# OCAT Connectivity Preparedness

OCAT, and all associated OCAT sites are accessibility through the Public Internet. Users will be able to access the OCAT URL's from any computer, as long as the user has access to internet.

In the event that your county prevents access to web pages on county machines, please use the following information to ensure that your users can access these URL's at Go Live.

Please Note:

1. Training begins on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Access to the OCAT Training Environment will be needed by that date. Prior to July 20<sup>th</sup>, Counties should ensure all county-specific internet restrictions are addressed by whitelisting the URL, if necessary.
2. Go Live is August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Access to OCAT Production URL will be needed at that time. Prior to August 24<sup>th</sup>, Counties should ensure all county-specific internet restrictions are addressed by whitelisting the URL, if necessary.

The OCAT Team will request response to a Training and Go Live check list, requesting that counties test and confirm that the URL's will work by these required dates.
