### Discussion Items

- CA-218200: DDID 1967: Update Cal-Learn Program Status and Worker Assignment for 57 Migration Counties

This is to discuss the design difference between C-IV and LRS, we need feedback from the Migration counties.

In LRS/CalSAWS, the Cal-Learn program is created in a Pending Status and is not initially assigned to a Worker. There are a series of LA County specific batch jobs to assign a Worker.

In C-IV, the Cal-Learn program is created in an Active status and assigned to the CalWORKs worker; it is then reassigned to a Cal-Learn worker through a Batch job.

The Batch job that reassigns the Cal-Learn worker was changed in LRS/CalSAWS to not update the Cal-Learn program.

- SCR C-IV-105086 – Waive Property Test for CE HHs as a discussion topic.

Current Design: HHs over 200% income are not MCE and must pass the resource test.

Request: HHs of only SSI/SSP recipients are CE and are not subject to the resource test

Recommendation: Waive the property test for SSI/SSP only HHs  
Assess all CE HHs for waived resource test.

We would like to raise awareness of this issue as we have seen an increase in CF cases discontinuing over resources, most likely due to CF expansion. We would also like to see it prioritized.
