Current Design:	LRS/CalSAWS 'Jail Match Interface's current design, upon finding a match, automatically journals the match, updates individual's 'Household Status' to 'Permanently Out of the Home' with the begin date being the date the individual was incarcerated, and updates the 'Living Arrangement Type' to 'Incarcerated'. The interface then triggers EDBC for General Relief to be run from the individuals date of incarceration to the batch run date's come up month. EDBC does not trigger for months that backdate further than 6 months. For instance, if an individual was incarcerated on Jan 1, 2019 and LRS/CalSAWS receives the incarcerated individual's record on Nov 20, 2019, EDBC triggers for the months of May 2019 to Dec 2019. If the incarcerated individual was in a two or more-person household and the incarcerated individual is a 'Payee' or 'Primary Applicant/Recipient', the worker is expected to manually update the 'Payee' and 'Primary Applicant/Recipient' to be the other non-incarcerated adult. If the 'Jail Match Interface' is unable to discover a match with 100% certainty, a task is created for the worker to review the case. 'Jail Match Interface' uses the same logic as 'online person search' when discovering matches.			
Request:	LRS/CalSAWS will enhance the 'Jail Match Interface' to include General Relief, CalWORKs, CalFresh, and Nutritional Benefit programs and further automate for case 'Payee', 'Primary Applicant/ Recipient' and 'Parental Control'.			
Recommendation:	Modify the 'Jail Match Interface' to include General Relief, CalWORKs, CalFresh, and Nutritional Benefit programs. Modify the 'Jail Match Interface' to automatically update 'Payee' if there are other aided adults in the household.			

	Modify the 'Jail Match Interface' to automatically update a program's 'Primary Applicant/Recipient' if there are other aided adults in the household. Modify 'Parental Control' to be the non-incarcerated parent if the incarcerated individual has parental control over the children in common with another aided adult in the household.
