OCAT update	<ul> <li>On track to start final systems test on 06/15/2020.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>CRFI 20-013 went out a few weeks ago, responses are due tomorrow. This will allow transfer of current users to the new OCAT system.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Closer to implementation date there will be an opportunity for Counties to add or remove users, so the most current user-base is up-to-date.</li> </ul>

	• Counties are not responsible for using any data fields for HSP, FSS, or HVP that has not been transmitted by CDSS directly to counties. Keep using case flags for HVP at this time for C-IV and LRS. CalWIN counties have already received phase 2 training.
