CER CA-210072 Additional Imaging Drawers for Merced County

Important Points

- Is this something other counties could use if needed and can the drawers be used for something other than APS?
 Example would be for APS. If we needed something for advocacy could we use this for that?
 Other counties would not have access to these drawers, and they could not be leveraged for anything else. The Imaging Solution has separate drawers and corresponding security that was deemed necessary at the functional design sessions. Additional drawers, included APS and MSSP, are needed only for Merced counties at this time.
- The documents will be associated to the Case Number and are the last two programs to be entered in the system for Merced.
- Outside of Merced County, are there any impacts to other counties that may influence voting? (Cost, timelines, etc) Merced county would need to pay for the additional drawers, and drawer would not be implemented until after all counties are on CalSAWS/Imaging.

 CA-214039 DDID 2509 - e-ICT Document Transfer Currently in C-IV if you want to see images in the context of the case you have to log in to the Perceptive Content box when it pops up. Will we have to do this with the new solution? CalSAWS is single sign on so if you are authentic to CalSAWS there is no need

CA-214039 DDID 2509 - e-ICT Document Transfer:

- There are specific docs required by the state that need to be sent in an ICT. The programs ICT'd will have the documents attached that the state mandates. There is a concern about the other documents that are not state required. Since these documents are not state mandated and are specific to the county, there are not considered as a requirement to send with an ICT.
- Question, when we receive an ICT from another county.
 Each document type is not separated. With the new solution, will it be separated? The intent is to pass it through OCR and translate into Hyland.
- From Hyland County to Hyland County, we have all the data elements to use. Scan a driver's license with paystub, it would need to be separated through the ICT process or the OCR
- Additional documents can be included with the ICT doc mapping if there is a need by all of the counties. We would need to evaluate this on an individual basis. Any potential changes would be done after all counties are on CalSAWS.
- Counties can send a journal entry Virtual Print into Imaging, and index/append to an ICT document.
- Is there a time standard for the batch to be completed? Will depend on the file sizes?
 - We don't have a standard timing now, and it's hard to determine until the system is in place. We are currently planning on every half hour. It would be the same day ideally in the hour.
- May have a separate meeting to focus on documents sent with ICT.

General Design Updates: CalSAWS Imaging - Design Revisions

Change "Exception Routing" to "Origin"

 We must change the label "Exception Routing" to "Origin" because "Origin" is hardcoded in Hyland's software, meaning that we cannot rename the "Origin" field. This field will still function the same and serve the same purpose, but will have a different label.

Security Updates

 We have to change how the Annotations security groups work because of limitations in Hyland's software.
 "Annotations Owner" was renamed to "Annotations," and allows users to create or hide all annotations. "Annotations

- Admin" was changed to allow users to create, edit, hide or remove any annotations.
- We added three new security groups for additional control over capture abilities.
