# **Medi-Cal CalHEERS Dispositions**

## **Purpose**

The purpose of this job aid is to provide information for viewing the information sent in the Disposition transaction that communicates to CalHEERS the final eligibility authorized by an Accepted and Saved EDBC and an Eligibility Override when appropriate. Once a Disposition is received, CalHEERS manages the downstream processes to maintain that the systems are in synch.

# **Disposition Transaction**

The Disposition transaction from the System communicates case and person linkage and eligibility information to CalHEERS.

The Dispositions also communicates:

- MAGI and Non-MAGI Medi-Cal eligibility authorized by the county worker for each person in the case.
- Eligibility information that includes Primary Aid Code, Program Status (Eligible, Ineligible, Discontinued) and begin and date dates.

Cash-based Medi-Cal received in Foster Care, Kin-Gap, AAP, RCA, and SSI programs are communicated to CalHEERS by marking Admin Verification of MEDS – Minimal Essential Coverage = Yes

With this change a Disposition will be sent for the Determination of Eligibility Response (DER) used in the EDBC, even if the DER benefit month does not match the EDBC benefit month, and the DER status is Reviewed. All other DERs in Reviewed status with the same benefit month will be marked as Suppressed.

The CalWORKs (CW) and CalFresh (CF) referral status and eligibility

 This includes the CW/CF referral status, primary aid code, CW/CF Eligibility, and the begin and end dates per program.

This change allows the transaction to be visible on the MAGI Disposition page. However, when CalHEERS successfully acknowledges the receipt of a Disposition transaction, the System updates the corresponding DER status to Complete. Additionally, there is no MAGI Medi-Cal Notice of Action generation information sent in the transaction.

## **MAGI Determination Summary page**

On the MAGI Determination Summary page, a column in the Search results Summary titled Disposition displays.

The following three statuses display and their hyperlink functions are:

- 1. Complete: The hyperlink refreshes to the MAGI Disposition Detail page
- 2. Error: The hyperlink refreshes to the MAGI Disposition Error page
- 3. Ready for Transfer: The hyperlink refreshes to the MAGI Disposition Detail page

Additionally, the column may display as a blank if no Disposition has been sent.

#### MAGI Referral Detail page

On the MAGI Determination page, a Dispositions button displays when there is a Disposition associated to a DER. When clicked this button refreshes to the MAGI Disposition List Page.

#### **MAGI Disposition List page**

The MAGI Disposition List page displays a list of Dispositions associated to a DER. The list includes Medi-Cal, CalWORKs, and CalFresh programs. The page is read-only and does not have edit capabilities. The page loads with the latest information first, then in a descending order. The page can be sorted by Programs and from/to dates.

### **MAGI Disposition Detail page**

The MAGI Disposition Detail page displays the information sent in the Disposition transactions to CalHEERS. This page displays case information, program person eligibility details and the status of the Disposition. This page is view only, and displays three hyperlinks:

- 1. Case Number: The hyperlink System Case Number opens the Case Summary page of the case
- 2. Status: When the Status is Error, the hyperlink opens the MAGI Disposition Error page
- 3. Initiated by: Displays the Staff person ID and the hyperlink opens to the Staff Detail page

The Close button on the page navigates the user to the prior page.

## **Person Association List Page**

The Person Association List page displays the case members included in the Disposition or EDR transaction. The page displays the Person Number of the System person to the CalHEERS person number.

The section label on this page will dynamically display the type of transaction. The Section label Persons included in the Request displays when the information is from an EDR, and the information is from the System's Individual Demographics page. The Section label Persons included in the Disposition displays when the information is from a Disposition transaction that has been sent to CalHEERS.

#### **Person Association Detail Page**

The Person Association Detail page displays the details for each person on the EDR or the Disposition transaction. The Agency column defines whether the information came from CalSAWS or CalHEERS.

### **MAGI Disposition Error Detail page**

The MAGI Disposition Error Detail page displays the error information received from CalHEERS on a Disposition. This page is read-only and does not have edit capabilities. This page will display a dynamically created section, titled either MAGI Request Error Detail (if the error is associated to a DER) or MAGI Disposition Error Detail (if the error is associated to a Disposition transaction.) The Disposition ID field on the page is only used if the error is associated to a Disposition and is hidden if the error is associated to an EDR transaction.

#### **eHIT Information**

The eHIT Disposition logic will always include the Program Referral Detail information for each person when sending the Disposition for an Accepted and Saved Regular EDBC.

Only one Program Referral Detail code is sent per person, per Disposition. A separate transaction is sent for each Referral Program Type Code when a Regular EDBC is Accepted and Saved for more than one program type at the same time.

**Example**: A Medi-Cal and CalWORKs EDBC are both Accepted and Saved for a case. The System would send two Disposition transactions: one Disposition for all Medi-Cal Eligibility and one Disposition for all CalWORKs eligibility.

A Disposition is sent for the CF program when the first CF regular EDBC is Accepted and Saved after receiving a DER with a Referral for CF. This will communicate to CalHEERS that the CF referral was processed and includes the CF eligibility. Further changes to CF will no longer be communicated to CalHEERS via a Disposition unless a new Referral is received from CalHEERS for CF. Additionally, the eHIT logic will not update the status of the DER from Reviewed to Complete based on a Disposition for the CF or CW programs; the DER status will only change based on the Disposition for the Medi-Cal program.

The eHIT logic includes an Override Reason in the Disposition transaction for the Medi-Cal program, when appropriate. The three eHIT Override reasons are:

- 1. Administrative Decision/ALJ Ruling
- 2. CalHEERS/SAWS Defect
- 3. Program/Regulation Not Implemented

The following chart is the System Override Reasons codes and how they are mapped to CalHEERS:

The System's Medi-Cal Deemed Infant is automatically mapped to the Override Reason Program / Regulation Not Implemented. The System does not require the user to mark a deemed infant with an override reasons, because this is automated.
