COVID SCRS – These Have received Emergency Approval, and no votes are needed- related to HR133 signed by president.

- CA-223408/CIV-108468 Increase allotment by 15% effective 1/1/2021
- CA-223409/CIV-108469 Batch EDBC to apply the CalFresh 15% Max Allotment
- CA-223410/CIV-108470 Exempt PUC
- Updates the CF maximum allotments by 15% effective January 2021. All EDBC runs after the implementation date will issue the new benefit amount. These amounts will be in effect from January 2021 to June 2021 benefit months.
- Batch will run for 01/2021, 02/2021 & 03/2021. January benefits will be issued as a supplement and all future months will receive the updated amounts on their regular issuance day. Will run for all three months on 2/6/2021 As well as also Nutritional benefits with the run reason of CF COLA with new subtype of 15% CF Allotment Adjustment.
- PUC income is being update to be treated as exempt income for CF effective 1/1/2021. A new entry for Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUC) income will be added on the back end to ensure PUC is counted through 12/31/2020 and will be exempt beginning 1/1/2021.

- Vote is due via email by 1/25/2021. LRS users are currently unable to update the customer reporting page if status is set to not applicable. As they currently manually update this page, it can be done in error and cannot be fixed. Conversation indicated this issue is primarily concerning the PR/RE for other programs such as GA program or Medi-Cal.
- This SCR is just in initial request to update the CFET activity types to match the 8 types that are listed on the STAT 47. The current plan is to only add activities that meet CFET criteria, however, if a county can justify another activity, they can reach out.
- Recently identified restrictions regarding the use of SSA data in a test environment limited the state's ability to adequately test automated implementation of the CalFresh SSI COLA. As such, the potential production issues could not be identified and resolved. CalSAWS received direction from CDSS on 12/28/2020 to not
