Important Points

- The Community Spouse Resource Allowance and MC LTC Community Spouse Needs Allowance values for 2020 and 2021 will be updated with this SCR.
- Although the 2020 values were released in March 2020, CalSAWS was unable to implement due to other priorities related to PHE.
- ACWDL 20-06 provides the 2020 values.
- Draft ACWDL provided the 2021 values. ACWDL 20-27 was subsequently released on 12/09/2020.
- Forms will be updated in CalSAWS to reflect the updated values. In C-IV, forms will be updated in a future SCR.
- Four (4) lists will be generated with this SCR that will require county action.
- All regions voted to approve this SCR.

The remaining batch MAGI sweep jobs will be updated with this SCR. The Auto-Rescind batch job will be updated in a future release (CA-220902) CalSAWS was updated with a Batch Skip reason if multiple MC programs exist and the RE Dates are not aligned. C-IV skips all cases with multiple MC programs. Elisa Miller – the BA's have been discussing cases with multiple MC blocks. Do we need to advise counties on such cases? We would provide a list to the counties via a CIT. Any benefit to doing this? We want to take into consideration county input since workload is heavy right now.  - Provided some background on the MC 604 MDV form used for Spousal Impoverishment (SI). CalSAWS is working on adding the form to the template repository. This form has 19 translations.
 - Question was asked regarding the translated forms and if staff is using them. Does staff send the English version of the form with the translated form? Are there similar situations with other forms that are translated. Will staff know to send both versions of the form?
 - CalSAWS will send a CRPC to DHCS.
