Important Points

CER for review

- CA-223698 CalFresh Recertification Denial Notice of Action

- Review of CER. Request is to include an adequate notice for a CF recertification denial when the client provides a signed application but does not complete an interview.
- Question was asked as to how the system will know if the client does not complete the interview? Have to update the customer schedule to indicate the client is a no show to an appointment.
- Questions were discussed regarding how the system will know if the signed application is received and the impact this could cause to workload
- Discussed how the CER could impact the CF 18
- All regions unanimously approved moving forward with the CER

Design Review

- CA-50303 Update WTW_REP Sanctions from Program Level to Person Level

- Review of SCR 50303, no vote taken
- How will this impact a PACF case, will the CF sanction also be imposed? The SCR is applicable to CW, and no changes are intended for CF functionality.
- Will the batch include a journal? Yes, there will be a journal entry
- Will a sanction be able to be imposed manually? Yes, workers will be able to add the non-compliance manually
- SCR will cause the sanction to be driven off the non-compliance page so records will follow a client from case to case.
- Concerns were brought up that this will not address issues with CF penalties

SCR Review

- CA-219543/CIV-108152 Updates to the CalFresh SSA COLA

- Reviewed SCR
- This will be a one-time process and will not be an ongoing batch. The goal is making it an annual process
- If the worker has already updated the amount will the batch skip the case? Yes, and the case should not end up on the exception list.
- SCR will be further reviewed at a batch memo call
