**Change Notice Number Nine**

**AMENDED RESTATED AND REVISED LEADER REPLACEMENT SYSTEM AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”) ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CALSAWS CONSORTIUM (“CONSORTIUM”), A CALIFORNIA JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY, AND ACCENTURE, LLP (“CONTRACTOR”) FOR THE PROVISION OF THE CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE AUTOMATED WELFARE SYSTEM (“CALSAWS”).**

Pursuant to Subparagraph 5.2.1 of Subparagraph 5.2 (Required Approvals) of Paragraph 5 (Change Notices and Amendments) in the Agreement, Consortium and Accenture agree to modify the Agreement to include changes that do not materially affect the scope of work, term, payments, or any term or condition of the Agreement except as provided in this Change Notice Number Nine. Consortium and Accenture hereby agree to the following modifications to the Agreement:

1. Consortium has allotted funding that may be used toward future work for Regulatory & Administrative (“R&A”) Change Budget Services, when the allocation for which is approved by the Consortium Executive Director and Accenture’s Project Director or their respective designees.
2. This Change Notice Number Nine requests Two Million Two Hundred Sixty-One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$2,261,127) to be used for an additional 18,687 hours for LRS Modifications and Enhancements (“M&E”) Services for State Fiscal Year 2020/2021, requested by the Consortium. The Consortium specifically agrees that some or all of these additional 18,687 hours for LRS M&E Services may be performed by Contractor’s Global Delivery Network (“GDN”) in excess of the maximum number of allowable hours calculated per Subparagraph 4.1 of the Agreement. Subsequent to the final approval of this Change Notice Number Nine, the revised maximum number of hours for LRS M&E Services for State Fiscal Year 2020/2021 will be 120,467 hours.

3. Item C of Section VI (M&O/M&E Assumptions) of Exhibit G (Estimates, Quantities, and Assumptions) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

“M&E Services will be a maximum of 96,000 hours per year through Contract Year 7 (through October 31, 2019). Furthermore, the maximum number of hours for M&E Services per State Fiscal Year will be:

- 107,000 hours for State Fiscal Year 2019/20 (service months from June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2020)
- 120,467 hours for State Fiscal Year 2020/21 (service months from June 1, 2020 to May 31, 2021)
- 32,000 hours for a portion of State Fiscal Year 2021/22 (service months from June 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021)”

4. Subsequent to the final approval of this Change Notice Number Nine, the balance remaining from the Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000) in Agreement Section 8.2.4 Regulatory and Administrative Change Budget Service of approved but unallocated funds for future work to be allocated will be Twenty-Eight Million Seven Hundred Seventy Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$28,770,456).

This Change Notice Number Nine shall be effective upon execution by Consortium and Accenture.

Except as provided in this Change Notice Number Nine, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
