Upgrades: From C-IV to CalSAWS



*AAP Automation

- After completing the two new AAP pages, 'AAP Summary' and 'AAP Placement', users can run Online EDBC. Online EDBC availability allows CNL and other Batch jobs to run for the AAP program.
- AAP Payments may be held and released at the case level when users select the "Hold" button on the AAP Detail page.

ARC Automation

- ARC Aid Codes are automatically applied on the Foster Care program when **both**:
 - The Placement Authority pages reflect non-federal eligibility, and the child is placed in the approved home of a relative
 - The ARC 1 Detail section of the Child Placement List page is completed

Kin-GAP

- The Non-Minor Dependent section has been moved from the Kin-GAP Summary page to a separate 'Non-Minor Dependent' page.
 - **Note:** When users make a selection of "Not Received" for the KG 3, a Skip Issuance occurs
- Kin-GAP Payments may be held and released at the case level when users select the "Hold" button on the Kin-GAP Detail page.

Resource Data Bank

- All Payees are located in the Foster Care Resource Data Bank, including payees for AAP and Kin-GAP programs.
- Foster Family Agency certified homes can be tracked on the new 'Foster Family Agency Certified Home' page associated to each FFA.

***Please note: Continuing AAP cases will not be automated at go-live. In order to utilize the new automation, users must manually enter the AAP information in the appropriate Data Collection pages. See the AAP Automation Video for more details.**
