Current Design: Currently when a FC placement is discontinued, LRS auto-tests for Medi-Cal and opens a Medi-

Cal program under the FC case with a 7J or 38 aid code. DCFS provides a hard-copy list of cases to DPSS to initiate the opening of the Medi-Cal program under a new DPSS case number and administer the (4M) Medi-Cal program. DCFS then discontinues the 7J/38 Medi-Cal only program. During CalWINS requirements session, the counties voted and received approval to have the auto-

test for the FC case result in a 4M Medi-Cal only program, instead of a 7J or 38 aid code.

Request: Streamline FCC process by changing EDBC logic to auto-test for 4M when youth 18 years or older

exits FC in order to ensure uninterrupted Medi-Cal benefits for youth transitioning out of Foster Care. The recommendations noted below represent a joint DCFS/DPSS solution as discussed at the

7/31/18 meeting.

discontinued for a child 18 years or above
