Request: If an Application (or Reapplication) for the discontinued CalFresh program comes in during the 30 days, the system "resets" the evaluation period for delinquency on the CalFresh Recovery Accounts to 90 days. Recommendation: The system should not reset the evaluation period when an Application (or Reapplication) for the discontinued CalFresh program is documented. The system should continue counting that same 30 days from the original discontinuance date.
