Removal of FC/KG Child from CW/CF

(Batch Job 1 PB19E466)

- 1. Runs every month two days before 10-day cut-off.
- 2. Looks for:
 - a. new placement on a FC/KG program that is Active or Pending; and,
 - b. the placement began on or after the first day of the current month; and,
 - c. the child is also Active in CW and/or CF.
 - d. the FC/KG placement is not in a family home facility; and,
 - e. the CW/CF payee is not the child's Parent with Parental Control.
- 3. For any child meeting those criteria:
 - a. Insert "Permanently Out of Home" Household Status record with Change Reason = "Child in FC/KG" for the child on the CW/CF case beginning when the FC/KG placement began (End Date any existing record).
 - b. Remove child from "Purchase and Prepare" and "Expense Contributors" for Shelter & Utilities.
 - c. Insert a journal entry indicating that the child was removed from the home and placed in FC/KG.
 - d. Trigger Batch EDBC on the CW/CF case for the month following the processing date.

(Note: Change reason "Child in FC/KG" on Household Status allows EDBC to ignore 10-day notice when removing the child from the CW program.)

Removal of FC/KG Child from CW after 10-day

(Batch Job 2 PB19E467)

- 1. Runs every month on the last day of month.
- 2. Looks for:
 - a. new placement on a FC/KG program that is Active or Pending; and,
 - b. the placement began on or after the day before 10-day cut-off; and,
 - c. the child is also Active in CW.
- 3. For any child meeting those criteria, do all the same actions as Batch Job 1, except:
 - a. Only trigger EDBC for CW; and,
 - b. Set the CW EDBC "Timely Notice Exception" flag to "Yes".
 - c. EDBC can discontinue the CW child as of the first day of the next month since 10-Day Timely NOA is not required in this scenario.
 - d. If the EDBC would result in an overpayment, batch will skip the case.

FC/KG Child Receiving CW/CF with Needy/Non-Needy Caretaker (Batch Job 3 (PB19E468)

- 1. Runs every month two days before 10-day cut-off.
- 2. Looks for:
 - a. new placement on a FC/KG program that is Active or Pending; and,
 - b. the placement began on or after the day before the previous month's 10-day cut-off; and,
 - c. the child is also Active in CW and/or CF; and,
 - d. the FC/KG placement is in a family home facility; and,
 - e. the CW/CF payee is the child's Parent and has Parental Control.
- 3. For any child meeting those criteria:
 - a. Insert a journal indicating that the child began to receive FC/KG.
 - b. Trigger EDBC for the next month. Child should be removed from CW/CF with the reason Gets FC/KG.
