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Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to inform all 58 CalSAWS Counties, the CalSAWS API Access Request Form is now available for distribution.</p> <p>Background Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) are now available in CalSAWS to allow Counties the ability to retrieve real time data, and for some APIs, the ability to submit data into the CalSAWS system.</p> <p>Approved APIs: Activities, Activity Agreements, Appointment, Barriers, Case, Documents, EBT, Imaging, Issuance, Journal, Person MDM, Person, Program, Reception Log, Service Agreement, Task, Time Limits, Verifications, Work Registration, Worker Info, Worker Schedule.</p> <p>Information To gain access to the APIs and API Developer Portal provided by CalSAWS, the County will need to submit an access request form for each of their applications that will be calling the CalSAWS APIs, to obtain the necessary security access tokens and to inform CalSAWS of the intended use.</p>
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	<p>Additional Information The CalSAWS API Developer Portal contains the design documentation, API specifications and test data for each of the released APIs.</p> <p>County Action Counties who wish to have access to the CalSAWS APIs, will need to fill out and submit the CalSAWS API Access Request Form for each of their applications.</p>
