

Image 2.0-1 - Weekly timeline of CalWIN Activities 07.26.21 – 08.01.21



- ➤ On August 08th, 2021 CalWIN ran the Foster Care clothing allowance COLA at a 96% success rate


3.0 Release Overview

This project is implementing a centralized repository and methodology to assist counties in data cleansing activities


Table 3.1-1 – Data Cleansing Support Tool



- Project is currently in wrapping up design and requirements. CUT is in progress
- ► On August 5th, 2021 CalWIN met with county Project Action Team to discuss requirements clarifications and get further input from counties on design
- ▶ Project is expected to implement base functionality, including 3 reports prioritized as high by the counties, on November 15th, 2021
- Project will phase in additional lists in future iterations

3.2 Release 66 (08/16/2021)






► CalWIN release tied to CalHEERS release



- ► CalWIN is monitoring 6 projects in this release for possible migration impacts






