Image icon disappears once selected. Cannot pull icon back up once selected. If other programs are available, icon can be selected for other programs. Icon only displays for Case Level documents. Icon will show immediately right after a document is submitted. Hyland will not open when icon is selected. Possible future SCR will be made to add viewable documents linked to icon.

Question:

So this is just a high level indicator to get the worker's attention to know there is a new image to review. Correct, this is only a notification to workers that an image is awaiting review is the past 30 days. Icon is separate from task generation. Icon comes prior to task generation creation.

Reports will pull according to worker ID selected. Report will only show for icons that has appeared within a case within the last 30 days.

Updated design document will be sent out.

Important Points

	 CA-231814 Change RC hold stamp to tell users exactly where images are held within record correction queues. This SCR will only apply to images processed after SCR has been implemented. Only documents that have been "fully submitted" into workflow/ case archival. If document is located within a County Queue, a clickable URL will be added to send you to the exact location of the document. Set to be released January 2023.
