

## **DDCR 3010 – Potential NOA Updates**

Functionality is being added for Mandatory/Optional Rules and On Aid on Another Case with DDCR 3010. When CF and/or CW fails for one of these status reasons should a NOA generate? If so, what reason should generate on the NOA? The following are the existing Fragment reason verbiage for the two status reasons.

### **C-IV CalWORKs Mandatory/Optional Rules – Fragment Id: 522**

To get Cash Aid, a person must be one of the following. <PERSON\_NAME> does not meet any of these rules.

- ◆ A parent or other relative who lives with and takes care of an eligible child
- ◆ A relative who lives with and takes care of a child who gets aid from SSI/SSP or Foster Care
- ◆ A legal guardian who lives with and takes care of a child who gets aid from Kin GAP
- ◆ A pregnant woman in the third trimester whose child would be eligible if born.
- ◆ A child under the age of 18
- ◆ An 18-year-old child is an eligible child only if:
  - 1) He/She is a full-time student in high school or in a vocational or technical training program, and he/she is expected to finish school before reaching age 19;
  - 2) He/She is a full-time student in high school or in a vocational or technical training program, proof requested by the County of his/her disability or services has been received, and he/she currently receives or has in the past received:
    - SSI/SSP benefits or;
    - IEP or Section 504 Plan or Regional Center services; or
    - Proof of a current or past disability.

If you are having problems getting the proof we need, call the county and we can help you try to get it.

### **C-IV CalFresh Mandatory/Optional Rules – Fragment Id: 907**

To get CalFresh, a person must be one of the following. <PERSON\_NAME> does not meet any of these rules.

- A child under 18 years of age, living with and under the parental control of a household member who is not his or her parent.
- Parents living with their natural, adopted or step children, or children living with their natural, adopted, or stepparents unless the child is 22 years of age or older and purchases food and prepares meals for home consumption separately from his/her/parents or is participating in the other parents CalFresh household.
- An individual living with the household who is a spouse of a member of the household.
- A boarder.
- Children of narcotic addicts or alcoholics who reside at a treatment center.
- A parent who shares joint physical custody of children on a 50/50 basis and in whose household the CWD has determined that the children are eligible to participate
- A woman or woman with children who are temporary residents of a shelter for battered women and/or children.
- An individual who is 60 years of age or living with others who is unable to purchase and prepare meals because he/she suffers from a disability considered permanent under the Social Security Act or suffers from a non-disease -related, severe, permanent disability.

### **C-IV CalFresh/CalWORKs On Aid on Another Case – Fragment Id: 312**
