1 OVERVIEW

1.1 Current Design

The Protective Custody Authority Detail page contains the Legal Authority Code field. This field is not mandatory and always displays on the page.

1.2 Requests

Per DDID 2097, add the Legal Authority field to the Protective Custody Authority Detail page. Update the Legal Authority Code to display based on the value in this new field.

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

Add the Legal Authority field to the Protective Custody Authority Detail page.

Update the Legal Authority Code field to dynamically display based on the value in the Legal Authority field.

Apply a data change to default the value of the new Legal Authority field based on the existing values of the Legal Authority Code field.

1.4 Assumptions

- Counties that do not utilize the Legal Authority Code should always select the default value of 'No' in the Legal Authority dropdown field, which will hide the Legal Authority Code dropdown on the Protective Custody Authority Detail page.
- 2. There are no changes to EDBC logic with this SCR. For example, existing logic to set aid code 40 when the Legal Authority Code exists will continue, regardless of what data is entered in the Emergency Assistance (EA) section.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Protective Custody Authority Detail

2.1.1 Overview

Add the Legal Authority field to the Protective Custody Authority Detail page. Update the Legal Authority Code field to dynamically display depending on the value in the Legal Authority field.




Figure 2.1.1 – Protective Custody Authority Detail Mockup

2.1.3 Description of Changes

- Add the Legal Authority field to the page. The values in this field are:
 - o No
 - o Yes

This field is not required, but it does not contain an empty option – one of the two available values is always selected. The default value for this field is No.

- Update the Legal Authority Code field to dynamically display based on the value of the Legal Authority field as follows:
 - o Hide the field when Legal Authority has the value No
 - Display the field when Legal Authority has the value Yes

2.2 Data Change – Legal Authority Field Default Value

2.2.1 Overview

Apply a data change to existing Los Angeles County records in CalSAWS to default the value of the Legal Authority field based on the value of the existing Legal Authority Code field.

2.2.2 Description of Change

Apply a data change to existing Los Angeles County records to default the value of the Legal Authority field based on the value of the Legal Authority Code field as follows:

 Default the field to Yes for all records with a non-null value in their Legal Authority Code field

2.2.3 Estimated Number of Records Impacted/Performance

Approximately 540,000 records will be affected by this change.

2.3 Foster Care Interface change

2.3.1 Overview

DCFS Data Mart sends information from CWS/CMS to LRS, which LRS uses to create and maintain Foster Care cases.

2.3.2 Description of Change

Update the LRS Foster Care interface to set the new Y/N value to Yes, if the Legal Authority Code exists. Otherwise, the Y/N field would default to N.
