Current Design: Currently the CIV_GetCaseMembers.js pulls back a list of all case persons, regardless of name length, if a document is indexed to a person with a name more than 40 characters long, the Imaging system will route the document into the county WS_Index_Error queue.

Request: Requesting that the script be updated to include an "if" statement for person names over 40 characters. Those names will be trimmed, to only display the first and last name, allowing the imaging system to index the documents assigned to those persons.

Recommendation: Modify line 133 of the CIV_GetCaseMembers.js script to include trimming logic within a nested if statement to shorten names too long for the imaging system to index. Attached CIV_GetCaseMembers.js with modifications needed, additionally attached CIV_GetCaseMembers-org.js as reference to original script.
