<p>C-IV Design: CO-068: SB75, Full Scope Medi-Cal for All Children (57535)- SB75 Section 35, WIC Section 14007.8(a) & ACWDL 16-12 Senate Bill 75 grants full scope MC to children under age 19, regardless of immigration status, if they meet all other eligibility criteria, effective May 1, 2016.</p> <p>Beginning May 1, 2016, CalHEERS will place these children into the appropriate full scope MAGI aid codes.</p> <p>This change in CalHEERS is addressed with CR 52030, and DHCS System Enhancement Request DHCS-0071. The authority for this change is found in Senate Bill 75, Section 35, and WIC, Section 14007.8(a).</p> <p>Recommendations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. EDBC Rules Updates<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) Update the logic that determines the MC aid codes for a given budget type to use Full Scope aid codes instead of the equivalent restricted aid codes based on the Restricted Aid Code Crosswalk for an individual if the following are true:<ol style="list-style-type: none">i. The person is a child under 19 years of age.ii. The benefit month being run is on or after the SB 75 Begin Date as defined above.b) Update the logic that determines benefit elections for Batch EDBC's to always elect MAGI for a person who is potentially eligible to both MAGI and non-MAGI benefits. <p>LRS Design: Please see attached LRS SCR 39410. SB75 functionality was implemented in release 16.04</p> <p>Design Difference(s): None. Both systems have the same logic to grant full scope MC to children under the age of 19, regardless of immigration status, if they meet all other eligibility criteria, effective 05/01/2016</p>
