- **Review of action items:**
- Research restoration of benefits at rescind vs. applying changes retroactively to disc date. MEDIL 15-22 ACWDL 15-27
 - Cases where packet/verifications are received prior to effective date of discontinuance are rescinded immediately.
 - Cases where packet/verifications received within the 90-day cure period are not automatically restored back to the effective date of discontinuance. Eligibility is reevaluated and benefits issued as determined.
- Additional information from DHCS regarding inmates and annual renewal will be shared at the next meeting for clarification.
 - **CRPC to be sent for clarification**
- Follow-up with DHCS regarding MC 355 CRPC #2047 if the original item requested is not provided.
 - **Need to follow up on the CRPC with additional questions**
- Deemed eligibility logic - Counties request to see a few examples to understand when this would be needed.
 - **Rejected. Workers should review for Deemed Infant status.**
- Discussion re: Medi-Cal MC355 character limit increase. Confirm character limit with Correspondence Team.

- Task (date) will be set after the DER shows conditionally eligible individual. ◦ When working the Task, a new Task will need to be set for the MC355.
