# Approval of C-IV Accenture Change Order CO-114 HVP

This Change Order adds scope to design, develop and implement enhancements to C-IV system to support the Home Visiting Program (HVP), formerly known as the Home Visiting Initiative (HVI), which is a new component of the CalWORKs program, pursuant to AB 1811 (Chapter 35, Statutes of 2018). The total cost of this Change Order equates to \$571,068.

# Approval of C-IV Accenture Change Order CO-115 Cal-OAR

This Change Order adds scope to develop and implement an outbound interface for the C-IV system to send certain data to CDSS for the CalWORKS Outcomes and Accountability Review (Cal-OAR), pursuant to SB 89 (Chapter 24, Statutes of 2017). The total cost of this Change Order equates to \$1,039,302.

# Approval of C-IV Accenture Change Order CO-116 Medi-Cal Full Scope Expansion

This Change Order adds scope to design, develop and implement enhancements to the C-IV system to support the expansion of full-scope Medi-Cal to the young adult population, ages 19 through 25, including undocumented individuals, pursuant to SB 104 (Chapter 67, Statutes of 2019). The total cost of this Change Order equates to \$336,777.

Approval of C-IV Accenture Amendment 106 (includes references to Change Order CO-114, Change Order CO-115, Change Order CO-116, and updates to Extension Two Cost Schedules and Exhibit A)

This Amendment 106 incorporates the abovementioned Change Orders (CO-114, CO-115, and CO-116). Funding for such Change Orders are covered through respective premise APDs. Current year costs are accounted for in the CalSAWS FY 2019-20 JPA Project Budget, which was approved by the CalSAWS JPA Board on June 28, 2019.

This Amendment 106 increases the contract value of the C-IV Agreement by \$1,947,147.

This Amendment 18 increases the contract value of the LRS/CalSAWS Agreement by \$2,183,894.
