Current Design: The Systems store the income information of the customers and use the income information to evaluate the eligibility for any program.

Customer's Social Security Administration (SSA) income is updated every year based on the new SSA income increase rate effective the month of January of that year. As Federal Poverty Level (FPL)-related budgets also use this updated SSA income information and the new FPL increase rate is not effective until the month of April for FPL budgets, The Systems use a 'Backout Multiplier' to account for the difference. The Backout Multiplier holds the current year's SSA income increase rate value. When handling FPL budgets, The Systems take the current SSA income amount and divides it with the Backout Multiplier (CT335_A2_SSA_INCOME_INCREASE_MULTIPLIER) which results in the SSA income amount being equal to the previous SSA income amount. It undoes the updated SSA rates for FPL-related budgets for benefit months January, February, and March.

DHCS provides the 'Pickle Disregard Computation Chart'. The Systems use this chart to determine the disregard amount for Pickle applicants and eligible persons.

EDBC compares the customer's income to the SSI/SSP payment standard amounts to evaluate the eligibility for certain budgets like '250% Working Disabled'.

Most beneficial logic is applied when CalFresh (CF), CalWORKs (CW), Immediate Need (IN), or Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA) EDBC is run for a mid-period month. As part of the most beneficial logic, if the countable amount of an existing income has increased, the system will instead use the previously counted, lower income value.

If a customer is paying the Medicare Part B premium, EDBC uses this amount as a deduction for certain budgets.

- Request:**
1. With the 2020 SSA Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA), SSA has approved a 1.6 percent increase for SSA benefits. This causes an increase in the income for a customer who is currently receiving the SSA benefits. Income information stored in The Systems for these customers will be updated to address the increase.
 2. The 2020 SSA COLA published SSA income increase rate is 1.6%. The current value of the 'Backout Multiplier' does not match with the updated rate increase and needs to be updated.
 3. With the 2020 SSA COLA information, DHCS provided the updated 'Pickle disregard computation chart' effective 1/1/2020. The Systems Pickle values will be updated to match the new chart.

4. With the 2020 SSA COLA, SSI/SSP payment standards are updated. The Systems will be updated to match the new SSI/SSP payment standards.

5. With the 2020 SSA COLA, income would increase for the customer who is currently receiving SSA. As this income increase is predicted, most beneficial logic will not be triggered.

6. The 2020 Medicare Part B Premium changed from \$135.50 to \$144.60. Medicare Part B Premium amounts stored in The Systems for these customers will be updated to address the increase.

Recommendation:

1. Apply a data change to add the new SSA income amount effective 1/1/2020 for a person receiving SSA income in continuing EDBC-based programs.
2. The 2020 SSA COLA published SSA income increase rate is 1.6%. Update the value of the 'Backout Multiplier' to match the rate increase.
3. Update The Systems Pickle values to match the 'Pickle Disregard Computation Chart' effective 1/1/2020.
4. Update The Systems to match the new SSI/SSP payment standards.
5. Income would increase for the customer who is currently receiving SSA. As this income increase is predicted, most beneficial logic will not be triggered.
6. Update Medicare Part B Premium amounts stored in The Systems for these customers to \$144.60 to address the increase.
7. Create a Journal entry to document the data changes for SSA Income and Medicare Part B Premium amounts.

Refer to attached Design Document for details on above mentioned recommendations.

Note: CIV-105046 will process Batch EDBC to cause the related benefit changes to be applied to the appropriate cases.

Medi-Cal EDBC rules will discontinue an individual from Non-MAGI Medi-Cal who is also active in another cash-based Medi-Cal program when Medi-Cal EDBC is run in Full Medi-Cal Hierarchy mode; however, Medi-Cal EDBC rules will only discontinue an individual from MAGI Medi-Cal who is also active on cash-based Medi-Cal through the CalWORKs program when running in MAGI-only mode. This incorrectly allows the individual to remain active in both MAGI Medi-Cal and another cash-based Medi-Cal program (other than CalWORKs).

When an individual is active on CalWORKs, The System communicates to CalHEERS that the individual is already a beneficiary of Medi-Cal in Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) which provides Minimal Essential Coverage (MEC) by sending 'MEDS-MEC' Administrative (Admin) Verification = 'Yes' in an Eligibility Determination Request (EDR); however, when an individual is a beneficiary on any other cash-based Medi-Cal (other than CalWORKs), The System does not send 'MEDS-MEC' Admin Verification = Yes in the EDR so CalHEERS may determine the individual MAGI Medi-Cal Eligible. This allows an individual to be active on both a cash-based Medi-Cal program (other than CalWORKs) and MAGI Medi-Cal.

When an individual is discontinued from the CalWORKs program, The System auto-tests the individual for Medi-Cal to provide continuity of medical coverage. Often, these individuals are active in Medi-Cal and then will subsequently have their CalWORKs termination rescinded, at which time the worker should run Medi-Cal EDBC to discontinue the Medi-Cal program for 'Gets CalWORKs'. When Medi-Cal EDBC is not run together with the CalWORKs rescind, the individual remains active on both CalWORKs and Medi-Cal.

Not all workers are permitted to run Medi-Cal EDBC with CalWORKs EDBC and sometimes the Medi-Cal program is on another case, so the individual remains active on both CalWORKs and Medi-Cal.

Current Design:

The Systems store the income information of the customers and use the income information to evaluate the eligibility for any program.

Customer's Social Security Administration (SSA) income is updated every year based on the new SSA income increase rate effective the month of January of that year. As Federal Poverty Level (FPL)-related budgets also use this updated SSA income information and the new FPL increase rate is not effective until the month of April for FPL budgets, The Systems use a 'Backout Multiplier' to account for the difference. The Backout Multiplier holds the current year's SSA income increase rate value. When handling FPL budgets, The Systems take the current SSA income amount and divides it with the Backout Multiplier (CT335_A2_SSA_INCOME_INCREASE_MULTIPLIER) which results in the SSA income amount being equal to the previous SSA income amount. It undoes the updated SSA rates for FPL-related budgets for benefit months January, February, and March.

DHCS provides the 'Pickle Disregard Computation Chart'. The Systems use this chart to determine the disregard amount for Pickle applicants and eligible persons.

EDBC compares the customer's income to the SSI/SSP payment standard amounts to evaluate the eligibility for certain budgets like '250% Working Disabled'.

Most beneficial logic is applied when CalFresh (CF), CalWORKs (CW), Immediate Need (IN), or Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA) EDBC is run for a mid-period month. As part of the most beneficial logic, if the countable amount of an existing income has increased, the system will instead use the previously counted, lower income value.

If a customer is paying the Medicare Part B premium, EDBC uses this amount as a deduction for certain budgets.

2. Lookup, Case, SSN field - The SSN field has no restriction/limitation. The user can enter as many characters on the field and can enter alphanumeric, numeric, or alpha characters.

C. DPSS External Mobile Application Issues:

1. Login to Your Case, Customer ID page - 'Forget your Password? Click to reset your password' link is not working with iOS. (Note: Android is working fine.) (Defect #209636 for 19.09 only fixed Android)

2. Case Verification Upload, Photo Library - Unable to scroll down to view the uploaded images from Photo Library when there are 2 uploaded images. This issue does not occur when there is only 1 image uploaded or more than 2 images uploaded.

Medi-Cal EDBC rules will discontinue an individual from Non-MAGI Medi-Cal who is also active in another cash-based Medi-Cal program when Medi-Cal EDBC is run in Full Medi-Cal Hierarchy mode; however, Medi-Cal EDBC rules will only discontinue an individual from MAGI Medi-Cal who is also active on cash-based Medi-Cal through the CalWORKs program when running in MAGI-only mode. This incorrectly allows the individual to remain active in both MAGI Medi-Cal and another cash-based Medi-Cal program (other than CalWORKs).

When an individual is active on CalWORKs, The System communicates to CalHEERS that the individual is already a beneficiary of Medi-Cal in Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) which provides Minimal Essential Coverage (MEC) by sending 'MEDS-MEC' Administrative (Admin) Verification = 'Yes' in an Eligibility Determination Request (EDR); however, when an individual is a beneficiary on any other cash-based Medi-Cal (other than CalWORKs), The System does not send 'MEDS-MEC' Admin Verification = Yes in the EDR so CalHEERS may determine the individual MAGI Medi-Cal Eligible. This allows an individual to be active on both a cash-based Medi-Cal program (other than CalWORKs) and MAGI Medi-Cal.

When an individual is discontinued from the CalWORKs program, The System auto-tests the individual for Medi-Cal to provide continuity of medical coverage. Often, these individuals are active in Medi-Cal and then will subsequently have their CalWORKs termination rescinded, at which time the worker should run Medi-Cal EDBC to discontinue the Medi-Cal program for 'Gets CalWORKs'. When Medi-Cal EDBC is not run together with the CalWORKs rescind, the individual remains active on both CalWORKs and Medi-Cal.

Not all workers are permitted to run Medi-Cal EDBC with CalWORKs EDBC and sometimes the Medi-Cal program is on another case, so the individual remains active on both CalWORKs and Medi-Cal.

Request:

- Medi-Cal EDBC rules shall determine an individual ineligible to Medi-Cal when an individual is also active in any cash-based Medi-Cal regardless of EDBC mode (Full Medi-Cal Hierarchy and MAGI-only).
- The System should inform CalHEERS that an individual is receiving MEDS-MEC in an EDR when the individual is active in any cash-based Medi-Cal.
- Run an on-going batch to discontinue the Medi-Cal for individuals who are in both Medi-Cal and CalWORKs as long as the most recently authorized EDBC was for CalWORKs.
- Add new Batch EDBC Sweep job that will trigger EDBC when the System receives a DERs that is associated to an EDR that initiated by the Duplicate Medi-Cal Clean-up batch (LRS only).
- Update the existing Find DER for EDBC Sweep job (PB00E120) to include DERs that is associated to an EDR that initiated by the Duplicate Medi-Cal Clean-up batch (C-IV only).

The NMD is eligible for benefits until the end of the month in which the NMD turns 21 years old.

Request: Per ACL 18-15 effective the date of implementation, an NMD on FC, ARC and KG program is eligible to receive benefits until the day before an NMD turns 21 years old. C-IV will add a new daily task sweep batch jobs that will run when an NMD is approaching 21 years old. In addition, LRS will add two new daily batch EDBC sweep jobs that will run when an NMD turns 21 years old for Foster Care program and two new monthly Batch jobs for KG program.

Recommendation: An NMD is eligible to federal benefits in Foster Care and Kin-GAP until the day before their 21st birthday.

A batch sweep will be added to create automated tasks for FC/ARC/KG cases with an NMD that is approaching 21 years old in C-IV. In LRS for Foster Care program, there will be two new daily batch jobs to trigger Batch EDBC on the day prior to the NMD child's 21st birthday. For KG program there will be two new monthly batch jobs to prorate the benefit and to discontinue the program after NMD child turned 21.

New NOAs will be added for the prorated month the NMD turns 21 year of age and for the following month of Discontinuance. This will obsolete the existing NMD Age Rules Reason Fragment.
