Current Design: CIV-11719 introduced functionality to exclude jpg/jpeg images from the ICT manifest to be exported. Prior to this defect, all case/person documents of a specific document type were requested/exported. In order for jpg/jpeg images to be excluded from the ICT manifest, the manifest file creation was modified to mimic that of the CalHEERs transfer. The new functionality utilizes the applicable date as one of the six keys that make up a composite key to differentiate documents. The issue is when a document to be pulled does not have an applicable date, the system treats this as a wild card and will pull all documents of that document type regardless of file type.

Request: Modify the document query process (using Message Agent) to obtain the Document Name (Doc_ID) which is unique for each document and use it in the keyfile to request documents from the Output Agent.

Recommendation: Keyfile can be constructed as
