Note: Negative action batch discontinuances were also suspended in C-IV for County Medical Services Program (CMSP) cases (aid codes 88, 89, 50 and 8F) per ACL 20-02 effective 4/1/2020.

CA-214393 was not able to suspend the automated discontinuance process for Verifications Past Due Date EDBC Batch Sweep (JB00E169M). This batch sweep applies to active CW, RCA, MC, FS, CAPI, and GR Programs. Verification requirements were not suspended for the other programs. The MC program cannot be split out from the batch sweep; therefore, the batch sweep cannot be stopped. This batch sweep applies to LRS/CalSAWS only. C-IV does not have functionality in Non-MAGI Medi-Cal EDBC to discontinue a Medi-Cal beneficiary when a required verification is overdue.

Additionally, other batch sweeps not intended for a targeted discontinuance from Medi-Cal (age sweeps, a case run through Batch EDBC in "all Programs Mode", etc.) may process a Medi-Cal program through Batch EDBC and result in a discontinuance from Medi-Cal due to either the required verification logic or other data collection in the case. This occurs in both C-IV and LRS.

To assist the MC workers to comply with the Governor's Executive Order (EO), a list of Medi-Cal individuals who became discontinued by batch EDBC after the EO will be provided to counties.

The following are allowable reasons and will be excluded from the lists: Discontinuance reasons:

- Calif. Residence
- Deceased
- Requested disc
- Duplicate Aid, i.e. Gets CalWORKs, Gets SSI, etc.

FRI reason:

Declined Elig

Note: In addition, the list will exclude cases where a user has processed EDBC online for the same benefit month subsequent to the identified Batch EDBC discontinuance.

Additional Information

In order to prevent Medi-Cal individuals from being discontinued for non-allowable reasons during batch, CA-215211/CIV-107421 - Prevent negative impacts in Batch EDBC to Medi-Cal beneficiaries due to Public Health Crisis or Natural Disaster have been created. These SCRs will:

- Add a Medi-Cal EDBC rule, that can be turned on or off with a CTCR, to
 prevent all adverse actions in Batch EDBC by saving the EDBC as Read-Only.
- Add a Batch EDBC skip that will skip the Medi-Cal EDBC program if the EDBC was saved as Read-Only from the above.

These SCRs are tentatively scheduled to be deployed in a priority release in 20.07. Once released, the lists created per CA-216783/CIV-107421 will no longer be required.

County Action

Workers will utilize these lists to evaluate restoration of benefits for customers discontinued by batch EDBC. Review the list to determine if county action is necessary.

List Name: Medi-Cal Individuals Discontinued [Effective Benefit Month(s)] by Batch EDBC

List Criteria: Any individual in the Medi-Cal program who was discontinued* by Batch EDBC on or after the date of the Executive Order, 3/16/2020, effective benefit month 4/2020 or later and remains discontinued* at the time the list is generated. Include the closure reason(s) and exclude programs assigned to a LA county DCFS worker. (DCFS worker lists are posted in separate LRS SCRs CA-215220 and CA-216190.) Exclude from the list, any beneficiary that was discontinued for the allowable reasons mentioned in the Background section.

*Discontinued - includes individuals who had benefits discontinued but remain Active FRI due to other individuals on the program.
