(Including any step-by-step instructions)	The purpose of this CIT is to notify C-IV and LRS counties that lists for SCRs CA-216183 CIV-107228 have been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal. Background California Department of Social Services (CDSS) Refugee issued All County Letter ACL) 19-76 (E) (EII) that changed the Earned Income Disregard and Income Reporting Threshold (IRT) Tier 2 amount. The policy allows a CalWORKS (CW) Assistance Unit (AU) to remain eligible with a Zero Grant (ZG) when their income is under the IRT Tier 2 level amount.			

Additional Information

SCR CA – 209033 / CIV - 104383 – ACL 19-76 - CalWORKs Change in Earned Income Disregard (EID) and Income Reporting Thresholds Tiers (IRTs); was implemented April 16, 2020 into the LRS and C-IV systems. The SCR updated the new policy effective June 1, 2020. The SCR applied the ZG IRT Tier 2 policy to CW applicants.

SCR CA – 216183 / CIV – 107228 - The CalWORKs Zero Grant Rule should not apply to Applicant (Intake Cases); updated to not apply the ZG IRT Tier 2 policy for CW applicants. The SCR is scheduled for implementation on Thursday July 2, 2020.

County Action

Until SCR CA 216183 / CIV - 107228 is implemented, current CW applicants with a Beginning Date of Aid (BDA) of June 1, 2020 or later that are granted a zero-dollar grant will need the following actions:

- Complete an override to deny the CW EDBC for over income.
- Generate a Manual Notice of Action, and
- Journal all actions taken according to your county's policy.

Additional County Action

A list is provided for active CW cases where a zero-dollar grant was determined for the intake month. **Only** the following counties have cases on the lists:

Review the posted list and follow your county policy to complete the county action.

- 1. Determine if the CW program is ineligible based on the ZG policy.
- 2. Run CW EDBC for June and July 2020 to close the program.
- 3. Complete an Override to make the program 'Over Income'.
- 4. Accept and Save the EDBC.
- 5. Manually generate a Notice of Action.
- 6. Journal all actions taken according to your county's policy.
