Additional Information As a result of these COVID-19 change efforts, a baseline EDBC for the new reporting period was not established. When batch EDBC was run to apply the Earned Income Disregard (EID) updates, there was not an EDBC to establish the new reporting period baseline. As a result, some income is **NOT** being considered as mid-period excluded and therefore is being counted when it should not be. This is resulting in customers receiving less benefits than they are eligible to receive. **County Action** 1.
