Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	<p>Purpose This CIT impacts all C-IV Counties. The purpose of this CIT is to inform counties of a list being posted associated to the Earned Income Disregard (EID) Batch Run.</p> <p>Background Per ACWDL dated April 2, 2020 (CalFresh Implementation Of The Families First Coronavirus Response Act: CalFresh Emergency Allotments), to increase food benefits in response to COVID-19 and its effects on the economy, California was approved to provide CalFresh (CF) Emergency Allotments to eligible CF and Transitional (TCF) households for the month of April 2020. To accomplish this request, the system generated manual EDBC records for April 2020 for all active CF/TCF programs which had not yet received an Emergency Allotment.</p> <p>Additional Information In some instances, the above mentioned manual EDBC is the most recent EDBC on record. When batch EDBC was run to apply the Earned Income Disregard (EID) updates, there were no valid income records to compare to. As a result, the system may have incorrectly excluded the income, and consequently, the customer may have received more benefits than they were eligible to.</p>
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	<p>County Action</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Per your county policy, review the lists of cases that have been affected by the running of the EID Batch. The list can be found at the following locations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. [REDACTED] A. If the income counted is correct. No action is required B. If the EDBC excludes income that should have been counted and an Overissuance (OI) is appropriate for June, the worker should establish it by running EDBC with the SAR 7 run reason. <p>Note: Running with the SAR 7 run reason may pull in other case changes that should not be actioned at the time. If a mid-period action is being taken that shouldn't, the county must override the EDBC.</p>
