- 9065 TRANSITION PERIOD EXPIRED MEDI-CAL REEVALUATION OVERDUE (This MEDS Worker Alert will be issued at MEDS Renewal in the month the PPCE period terminates if there is no recorded eligibility in MEDS for the upcoming month).

PPCE individuals are to be provided the MC 61 and PPCE Flyer (attachments below) at one of the following intervals (at minimum):

- Report a pregnancy
- Report the end of pregnancy
- Report a birth
