When the 'Current or Offered Health Program' of "None of the Above" is sent in an EDR, the 'Free Medicare Part A' indicator is required and is sent as "No". If the 'Current or Offered Health Program' is anything other than "None of the Above", the 'Free Medicare Part A' indicator is not required and no value is sent for the indicator.

Note: The 'Free Medicare Part A' indicator is only required when sending 'Current or Offered Health Program' of "None of the above". LRS/CalSAWS never sends "Yes" for 'Free Medicare Part A' indicator because if a Medicare record exists for the EDR benefit month, the 'Current or Offered Health Program' is "Medicare" in the EDR.
