Current Design: A Medi-Cal EDBC rule does not exist to prevent adverse actions (discontinuances, reduced benefits or increases in out-of-pocket expenses) to Medi-Cal beneficiaries during a Public Health Crisis or Natural Disaster when EDBC is run through batch.

Request: During a Public Health Crisis or Natural Disaster, the SAWS may be instructed by the Federal, State or Local Government to prevent adverse actions to Medi-Cal beneficiaries for a specific timeframe. These requests often come with an expedited need to implement in The Systems.

1. Add a Medi-Cal EDBC rule, that can easily be turned on or off, to prevent all adverse actions by saving the EDBC as Read-Only when EDBC is run by Batch.

Note: These protections only apply to Medi-Cal EDBC run in batch; this allows users to control online Medi-Cal EDBC for case management of unique scenarios during the Public Health Crisis or Natural Disaster.

CalHEERS is the system that determines MAGI Medi-Cal Eligibility. The Systems will protect a MAGI Medi-Cal beneficiary from being discontinued during Batch EDBC during the Public Health Crisis/ Natural Disaster, but The Systems will not add a protection to prevent an increase in Premium or reduced scope for MAGI Medi-Cal as this is determined by CalHEERS.

Recommendation: 1. Add a Medi-Cal EDBC rule to save an EDBC as "Read-Only" with the 'Read-Only Reason' of "Protection due to Public Health Crisis/Natural Disaster" when the beneficiary will be adversely impacted by non-allowable reasons during the Public Health Crisis/Natural Disaster and the EDBC is run in batch.

Save the Medi-Cal EDBC as "Read-Only" for the above reason when any of the following are true:

a. Discontinued Benefits: Any Medi-Cal program person changed from either Active MEM or Ineligible MEM to Discontinued or Active FRI in the EDBC for a non-allowable reason.

- Calif. Residence
- Deceased
- Declined Elig
- Gets AAP
- Gets ARC
- Gets CalWORKs
- Gets Duplicate Aid
- Gets FC
- Gets Kin-GAP
- Gets SSI
- Gets SSI/SSP
- Inter-County Transfer
- Moved out of County (CMSP)
- On Aid Another Case
- Requested Disc. - Written
- Requested Disc. - Written inc. MC
- Requested Disc. (CMSP) - Add Person
- Requested Disc. (CMSP) - Reapply with Budget Change
- Requested Disc. (CMSP) - Verbal

b. Increase in premium or SOC: Any Medi-Cal program person changed from a non-premium primary Non-MAGI Medi-Cal aid code to premium primary Non-MAGI Medi-Cal aid code or had an increase in SOC.

Note: CalHEERS only has premium aid codes for children and CalHEERS protects a child with soft pause when the MAGI Medi-Cal non-premium aid code is changing to a MAGI Medi-Cal premium aid code. This protection will not be included in updates to The Systems Medi-Cal EDBC rules.

c. Reduction in scope: Any Medi-Cal program person changed from MEM on a full scope primary Non-MAGI Medi-Cal aid code to a limited or restricted scope primary Non-MAGI Medi-Cal aid code.

Note: CalHEERS determines if an individual is protected with soft pause for a reduction in scope for MAGI Medi-Cal. This protection will not be included in updates to The Systems Medi-Cal EDBC rules.

2. The new Read-Only Medi-Cal EDBC rule from Recommendation 1 will be implemented such that it can be turned on or off by a CTCR-only change. The new rule will be implemented turned on and will be turned off in a future SCR upon DHCS guidance.

The SCR will be prioritized through the normal prioritization process and implemented as a general batch skip to be implemented in a future baseline release.

06/03/2020 - DHCS released MEDIL I 20-14 on 5/31/2020, that extends the suspension of discontinuances until notified. Updating the label back to COVID-19 and addressing with this pandemic.
