The costs included in the workbook are estimates and subject to change based on actual costs as paid each month, subsequent allocation adjustments and updates to the CalACES Implementation Advance Planning Document (IAPDU), CalSAWS IAPDU, and CalWIN IAPDU. The costs reflected on the summary tabs of the workbook account for the quarterly invoice/claim process and the individual county shares are based on the applicable SFY Persons Count.
