The code currently prevents impacts to customers from increases in Share of Cost (SOC), but not increases in premiums. CR CA-222705/CIV-108409, implemented in release 21.01, added protection to prevent increases in the 250% Working Disabled Program (250% WDP) premium impounts by saving the EDBC as Read-Only when EDBC is run by Batch.			

The 250% Working Disabled Program allows certain working disabled individuals to become eligible for Medi-Cal by paying low monthly premiums based on net countable income.

If a customer needs to get a reimbursement of paid premiums, please refer them to contact the following: 250% WDP at (916) 445-9891. The hours of operation are Monday through Friday 8:00am - 5:00pm. They are closed from 12:00pm-1:00pm, on weekends and State Holidays. The customer will need to provide verification of the payment when requesting the refund. Example: copy of canceled check(s), copy of bank statement, and/or EFT reference number. More information can be found in the attached PDF and online at Working Disabled Program.

- Generate a manual NOA and
- Journal actions taken on the case

The premium should be corrected back to the old premium for any months that were not protected with a read only Batch EDBC during the Public Health Emergency (PHE).
