Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	<p>Purpose</p> <p>The purpose of this CIT is to provide all 58 counties with updated information on the outcome of State (California Department of Social Services (CDSS)/Department of Health Care Services (DHCS)) and Stakeholders (Advocate) review of Non-State Forms (NSF) migrating to CalSAWS. This CIT provides updates to the original CIT 0218-20 distributed on October 29, 2020.</p> <p>Background</p> <p>As discussed in many forums, there is an overall goal for the consortium to develop a single set of NSFs to be used with CalSAWS. The consortium worked with the counties and the State to review the top used NSFs by the various consortium systems and create a single form for the CalSAWS when possible.</p> <p>Upon completion of this effort, the State reviewed the forms to determine if they should become state forms or remain an NSF. NSF that became State forms were sent through the State process and they provided feedback and comments on the remaining 98 NSF.</p> <p>Additionally, to increase communication with our Stakeholder Community, CalSAWS sent the 98 NSF to Stakeholders (Advocates) for review.</p>
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	<p>Stakeholders were given the opportunity to provide comments and suggest changes for each of the 98 NSF. Suggested changes were reviewed and either added to the form or rejected. The reasons for rejected suggestions were communicated back to the Stakeholders.</p> <p>Please note that the process of sending NSF to CDSS/DHCS and Stakeholders for review will continue for newly created NSF and NSF with major changes to content.</p> <p>Additional Information This CIT provides the counties with the following information in the attached Excel spreadsheet:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • List of NSF to become new State forms. • List of NSF to remain as NSF. These updated forms will be available in the CalSAWS template repository. • List of NSF that were obsoleted and will not be available in CalSAWS. <p>In addition to the lists, we are providing counties with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New State form numbers/names, if known. • Reasons the form was obsoleted. • DDID/SCR#s associated with the forms. • Current Status and release at the time of publication of this CIT. • New NSF names due to new CalSAWS naming convention, if known. <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The information found in the attachment is a point in time. CRs are in process and changes occur.
