CalSAWS Portal/Mobile (BenefitsCal) UAT includes two phases as described below:

UAT Preparation Phase – (April 19, 2021 – May 28, 2021)

- Participate in a UAT Kickoff
- Review test scenarios/cases to identify additional scenarios needed for validation.
- Participate in self-paced trainings focused on BenefitsCal functions
- Time commitment: Self-paced, as time permits.

UAT Execution Phase – (June 1, 2021 – July 09, 2021)

- Execute test scenarios/cases
- Document results and findings
- Participate in daily meetings
- **Time commitment:** Full-time (i.e., Monday: Noon-5pm, Tuesday-Thursday: 9am-5pm, Friday: 9am-noon) commitment for a minimum dedicated two-week period.
