#### Purpose

The purpose of the CIT is to inform Los Angeles and CIV counties that the SCRs CA-226328 / CIV-108752 List of CalWORKs Denial Case Fail for Applicant Test have been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal.

#### Background

[Executive Order N-59-20](#) signed by Governor Newsom on May 1, 2020, orders the exemption of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act

**Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUC)** payments **did not** exempt from consideration as income in determining eligibility for CalWORKs/RCA/ECA/TCVAP applicants; therefore, PUC must be treated in the same manner as regular state unemployment insurance benefits at **application**.

However the guidance in [ACL 21-22](#) is effective March 1, 2021 and supersedes guidance issued via All County Welfare Directors Letter [ACWDL May 5 2020](#). Per [ACL 21-22](#) PUC is exempt for CW for both **applicants** and **recipients** from **January 1, 2021** through October 31, 2021.

If customers receive <b>PUI</b> payment, the <b>income type</b> <u>Pandemic Unemployment Compensation</u> <b>must</b> be selected.</li> <li>2. For CalWORKs/CalFresh (CW/CF) combo case, remember to also run EDBC for the CalFresh program to ensure the CWs grant is counted in the CF budget correctly.</li> </ol>
