- Sowmya reviewed SCR CA -222369 providing background information and expected changes
- Jobs JB00E906D and JB00E907D are not currently in CalSAWS and are currently turned OFF. It is recommended that they be turned ON.
- Maria asked how counties will know to open 4M MC cases, since batch will be discontinuing these cases. **A: Current system logic will apply.** CalSAWS provided SCR 226507 which is a report of aid code 45 cases.
- Region 6 requested to expand SCR job to include age rate increases and changes that were previously turned on for LA. **A: if changes are made and added, it would push out the implementation date so changes cannot be accommodated at this time. However, to make changes, a new SCR would be required. Region 6 will open a CER to complete this action.**
- Region 6 asked for clarity in the language of this SCR, discontinuance or what results are expected. **A: batch would run like others batch job with system logic being the results.**
- Celia asked if aid 45 would be included. **A: No Medi-Cal logic will be changed.**
- CalSAWS explained no changes to Medi-Cal logic will be performed and that this SCR is only to initiate a sweep to identify 21yr old's for FC discontinuance.
