Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	Purpose (Identify what Counties this CIT affects) The purpose of this CIT is to provide the 39 C-IV counties a draft version of the CalSAWS Migration Training Guide (MTG), which serves as a course catalog for C-IV Migration Training. The CalSAWS MTG contains a list of curriculums and associated training materials that are hosted in the CalSAWS Learning Management System (LMS). The CalSAWS LMS will serve as the system that will host C-IV Migration training materials to prepare end-users for CalSAWS Go-Live on September 27, 2021. The final version of the CalSAWS Migration Training Guide will be posted in the CalSAWS LMS by July 5th, 2021.  Background All C-IV Counties will be migrated to CalSAWS on the Go-Live date of September 27, 2021. In preparation for this migration, the MTG will provide active end users with a list of training materials, including WBTs, supplemental training guides by topic/area and much more.  *Current active C-IV end users are defined as users that have logged into the C-IV system in the last 1 year. All C-IV active users will be provided access to the LMS.	

The Migration Training Guide is a catalog of C-IV Migration LMS training. It provides the following information:

- Curriculum Structure and Total Durations
- Curriculums and recommended audience
- WBT descriptions and approximate duration
- Quick Guide and Reference Guide descriptions and recommended audience

## Additional Information

Migration training material consists of the following:

- **Web-based Trainings (WBTs):** Web-based Trainings (WBTs) are self-guided eLearning modules that can be taken at a user's own time and own pace.
- Quick Guides: Quick Guides are optional supplemental documents which
  include helpful information such as functional instructions, screenshots, and
  field values. Some Quick Guides are associated with a particular WBT (as
  specified in the Migration Training Guide) and others are stand-alone topics.
- Reference Guides: Reference Guides are optional supplemental documents which may include an introduction to new elements previously unavailable in C-IV for specific topics. They may also contain side-by-side comparisons of terminology, page name changes, mapping, related fields, buttons and drop list values.
- Job Aids: For the C-IV Migration Training program, the job aids listed in the CalSAWS MTG are either new or updated per new CalSAWS functionality.

Participants in Early Training, Imaging Train-the-SME (ITTSME) and the Additional LMS Access Option will be notified of their LMS access date through their respective CRFIs and/or other communications. All active C-IV Users will have access to the CalSAWS LMS by General Training (August 30 – September 24, 2021).
