Description:	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to notify LRS and C-IV counties that lists for SCRs CA-228480/CIV-108997 CalFresh Emergency Allotments for May 2021 have been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal.</p> <p>Background To increase food benefits in response to COVID-19 and its effects on the economy, California was approved to provide CF emergency allotments to eligible CF and TCF households. CDSS communicated the approval of CalFresh emergency allotments for the following benefit months:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> March and April 2020 CalFresh emergency allotments through ACWDL dated April 2, 2020 (CalFresh Implementation Of The Families First Coronavirus Response Act: CalFresh Emergency Allotments) May 2020 CalFresh emergency allotments through ACWDL dated 05/21/2020 June 2020 CalFresh emergency allotments through ACDWL dated 05/21/2020 July 2020 CalFresh emergency allotments through ACWDL dated 06/23/2020 August 2020 CalFresh emergency allotments through ACWDL dated 08/03/2020

For the benefit months from March 2020-March 2021, all CF and TCF households not already at the maximum allowable allotment based on household size are eligible to receive a CF emergency allotment.

Example: A household of two (2) received \$150 in CalFresh benefits in April 2020 then received a \$205 CF emergency allotment on May 9th to bring them up to the maximum allotment amount of \$355 for two (2) people. CF households that previously received the maximum allowable allotment based on household size are not eligible to receive CF emergency allotments.

Effective the April 2021 benefit month and moving forward, all CalFresh households will receive a minimum emergency allotment of \$95 per month. This new minimum emergency allotment applies regardless of household size:

- Households eligible to receive the maximum allowable allotment based on household size are now eligible to receive an emergency allotment of \$95 per month.
- Households who are not eligible to receive the maximum allowable allotment based on household size, but whose emergency allotment is less than \$95 per month under the previous model, will receive additional CalFresh benefits to raise their emergency allotment to the new \$95 minimum.
- Households who were eligible to receive more than \$95 per month under the previous model will continue to receive that amount.

SCRs CA-228480/CIV-108997 CalFresh Emergency Allotments for May 2021 was implemented on 06/12/2021. This SCR issued emergency CalFresh benefits to CalFresh (CF) Households under the **old emergency allotment rules for the March 2021 benefit month, and the new \$95 minimum rules for the April and May 2021 benefit months.**

Additional Information

	<p>CalSAWS implemented an automated process to issue the CF emergency allotments for eligible CF and TCF households. Previously, the CF emergency allotments were issued as a 'Supplemental Disaster CalFresh' (Supp DCFP) benefit type on the household's EBT card. However, with SCR CA-218299/CIV-107689 and moving forward, the emergency allotments will be issued as 'Emergency Allotment Food Benefits' (CF03) benefit type.</p> <p>An automated journal entry was added to all cases receiving a CF emergency allotment.</p> <p>March, April, and May 2021 benefit month emergency allotments generated on June 12th are available to the recipient as of June 13th.</p> <p>Users will be able to view these emergency allotments on the 'Issuance Detail' page as 'Emergency Allotment' in the Subcategory field; the allotments will also be visible on the 'CalFresh EDBC Summary' page. Since the CF emergency allotments are issued as an Emergency Allotment (CF03) benefit type, County users are <u>not</u> able to issue these emergency allotments through the system manually.</p> <p>Cases that receive a Validation/Submission error can be found on the 'Issuance Exception Report' and will need to have action taken to avoid a duplicate error in the next run.</p> <p>NOTE: The next CF emergency allotment batch issuance will occur of Saturday, July 17, 2021. This run will include the first emergency allotment issuance for June 2021, the 2nd issuance for May 2021, and the 3rd and final issuance for April 2021.</p> <p>County Action</p> <p>Per your county policy, review the lists of cases that have been affected by the implementation of CA-228480/CIV-108997 CalFresh Emergency Allotments for March List Posted.
