Memorandum Purpose:

This memorandum is intended to convey the batch EDBC scope for SCR CA-228338/CIV-108983 Batch EDBC for Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for Income In-Kind (IIK) for 2021-2022, county actions and schedule for the referenced program changes.

Scope:

Per All County Letter (ACL) 21-55, policy will be implemented in C-IV through SCR CIV-108979 and in CalSAWS through SCR CA-228323 as part of the 21.06.10 release on 06/10/2021.

To minimize the work required by the counties, the project will take the following actions:

1. Batch:

- a. Run a Batch EDBC in Targeted program mode, for all cases with CalWORKs and RCA programs with an active or ineligible program person who has an income record of type 'Income In-Kind', effective for 07/2021. The Targeted program mode will process EDBC for CW, RCA, CF, NB, IN, and DV programs from the identified cases which includes all the CW/CF(including NB) combo cases.

Note: Because EDBC applies the lower of the standard amount and the Amount Provided, both populations are included.

Exclude the following cases:

- i) The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
- ii) The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 06/2021 and the report status is Sent, Received, or Incomplete
- iii) CW/RCA EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-228323/CIV-108979 went to production.

- b. CalSAWS only: Run the above population with run reason 'In-kind Income COLA'.

2. NOAs:

All notices will be sent to the Central Printing facility the night of the batch EDBC process.

3. Journal:

CalSAWS: A journal entry will be created for each program run by the batch EDBC process. This will be the standard journal entry added by the batch EDBC process.

Journal Category: Eligibility



Journal Type: Batch EDBC

Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].

2.a. Cases where a program was discontinued by the batch EDBC process. Include additional columns to indicate program type and program closure reason	These are likely the result of household changes or ongoing data collection which were not yet processed through EDBC. Since the purpose of this Batch EDBC process was not to close households, review these cases to verify the closure was accurate.
2.b. Cases where the batch EDBC process closed a person on a program. Include an additional column to indicate program type	These are likely the result of household changes or ongoing data collection which was not yet processed through EDBC. Since the purpose of this Batch EDBC process was not to close persons, review these cases to verify the closure was accurate.
2.c. Cases where the batch EDBC process resulted in CalWORKs benefit reduction. Include additional columns to indicate each of the benefit reduction type in a separate column (Household/AU Size Change, Income Change, Proration Change, Over Payment Adjustment Change)	These are likely the result of household changes or ongoing data collection which was not yet processed through EDBC. Since the purpose of this Batch EDBC process was not to reduce benefits, review these cases to verify the benefit reduction was accurate.

Development Schedule

1. Review the batch process schedule with counties on 06/09/2021.
2. Deliver the driving query and list queries to the System Test team on 06/11/2021.
3. System Testing will occur between 06/11/2021 and 06/19/2021.
4. Run batch EDBC in production for both systems on 06/19/2021.

Things to remember about these batch EDBC processes:

- All impacts from SIRs and SCRs which have not been implemented will continue to occur during the batch processing.
- There are multiple reasons why a program may not be successfully run through batch EDBC processing. Some examples include: No Worker Assigned, Overridden Program Case, and Pending Program/Person/Application. Please review tasks and the Batch Eligibility Report daily.
- The EDBCs will have an EDBC Source of 'Batch EDBC Rules'.
- When a user runs EDBC in which a prior pending month exists, the EDBC will have a type of Read-Only. When running Batch EDBC that restriction does not apply and these EDBCs will not be Read-Only.
- Any updates or lack of updates made/not made to cases will impact the batch EDBC results. This means programs may be discontinued (due to non-compliances, etc.) unexpectedly.
- All notices will be generated normally.

County Action:

- Review cases included in the lists and take necessary action.
- Review the Batch Eligibility Report and action cases which could not be processed. This report is an on-request report available under Global: Reports > Local: On Request >

Task: Administrative. If you do not see this report, please contact your Security Administrator for rights. To see cases not processed select a status of 'Not Processed' on the Reports Parameters pages

Schedule Considerations:

- Both systems will not be down during batch processing on Saturday, June 19, 2021
- Batch jobs scheduled for each evening will run after the batch EDBC process completes.
- Approximately 1000 active programs will be processed in C-IV for the benefit month of 07/2021.
- Approximately 700 active programs will be processed in CalSAWS for the benefit month of 07/2021.
- Approximately 50,000 programs processed per hour via batch EDBC.
- The System cannot run batch EDBC processing during the following:
 - Main Payroll
 - Foster Care Main Payroll
 - SAR7 Discontinuance
 - RE Discontinuance
 - 10-day Discontinuance
 - CalFresh Recertification Discontinuance
 - Primary Period of Maintenance (PPM) [C-IV Only]
 - 6:30 AM - 9:00 PM, Monday through Saturday

Timeline:

- Expected CIV Batch EDBC processing: 06/19/2021.
- Expected CalSAWS Batch EDBC processing: 06/19/2021.
