Current Design: In CalSAWS, the benefit issuances are created via EDBC authorization records and Supportive Service Payment

issuances are created via Payment Request authorization records. There are daily and monthly issuance batch jobs that will attempt to create issuances for these authorization records. If an issuance fails to be created during

batch, the issuance will be logged in the Skipped Issuance Report.

Request: Introduce a framework in CalSAWS that can be used to issue payments through the system without making

any significant changes for policies in the short time. Moreover, this framework can be used to issue additional

supplemental payments for individuals who are not the primary payee on the program.

Create a new Auxiliary Authorization Detail page.

Update the Issuance Detail page.

Create new Nightly Auxiliary Authorization Issuance Sweep procedures.

Current Design:

Per CA-207140, any Foster Care, Kin-GAP, or AAP placements with a D or F rate will have the SCI portion of the rate separated on the EDBC Summary. This creates a FC_EDBC record with the SCI End Date set to the end of the benefit month under the EDBC. Setting SCI End Date as the end of the benefit month will trigger Skip Issuance framework to stop issuance from going out. The Skip Issuance framework validates the issuance benefit month against the SCI End Date of the FC EDBC record for the "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" skip issuance reason. The "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" skip issuance reason has been turned off to allow issuing benefits for Los Angeles county in CalSAWS.

Request:

- 1. Update EDBC and Skip Issuance logic for FC/KG/AAP to be able to skip issuances that contain SCI amounts originating from the data collection pages.
- 2. Turn the skip issuance reason "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" on again in CalSAWS for Los Angeles county.

Recommendation:

- 1. Update FC/KG/AAP EDBC to set an indicator if the SCI rate is from the SCI data collection pages and not from the D or F rates. This change will not be visible to users and will be stored in the database backend only.
- 2. Update the Skip Issuance reason "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" to check for an active SCI data collection record if the regular EDBC includes a SCI from the data collection pages.
- 3. Update the Skip Issuance reason "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" to include AAP program.
- 4. Turn on the Skip Issuance reason "End Dated SCI Exists on EDBC" for Los Angeles County.

Current Design:	In the CalSAWS system, only ONE active mileage rate is allowed where there can be a threshold define to have a second rate active if the required miles go over the threshold defined. In C-IV system, there can be more than one mileage rate active at any given point in time.							
Request:	For the C-IV and CalWIN counties to adapt to the CalSAWS functionality, where there can be only one rate (with higher and lower threshold defined), updates are required to Mileage Rate Detail page in CalSAWS to allow the county users to create mileage rates for a past period. Furthermore, add the effective dating logic on the page when a user tries to create an overlapping mileage rate record.							
Recommendation:	 Remove the current validation on the page which restricts the user from creating a mileage rate for a past period. The current validation message states – "Begin Date - Date entered cannot be prior to current date". Update the page to add effective dating logic on the click of Save and Return button Do a DCR to purge old data for CIV counties that was converted to CalSAWS during the LRS go-live as part of baseline. This DCR will not affect any existing values for LA county in CalSAWS today.
