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1 OVERVIEW

According to ACL 20-97, CDSS has developed a state-funded pilot program to provide time-limited supplemental nutrition benefits to CalFresh households that meets the following criteria:

- Reside within a disadvantaged community.
- Receive drinking water from a public water system that does not meet primary drinking water standards under the California safe drinking water Act.

The CDSS collaborated with the California Food Policy Advocates (CFPA), the county Welfare Director's Association (CWDA) of California, State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), impacted Counties and other impacted partners. Based on the recommendation of the workgroup, Kern County was selected to implement the Safe Water Pilot program. Due to the limited funds available for the Pilot, it is not feasible to serve an entire county and have a meaningful, measurable impact. To keep the pilot population to a feasible size, two key Pilot design elements were used to narrow the eligible population: residential ZIP_Codes and an out-of-compliance community water system.

Per ACL 20-97, Active CalFresh households with a physical address in one of the pilot ZIP Codes (93241 (Lamont), 93220 (Edison), 93243 (Gorman-Lebec), 93311 (Bakersfield), 93387 (Bakersfield), 93386 (Bakersfield)) will be eligible to receive pilot benefits in the amount of \$50 per month in food benefits during the Pilot Eligibility period of 12 months or as long as funding is available (whichever is earlier) starting **March 1, 2022**.

1.1 Current Design

In CalSAWS, benefit issuances are created via EDBC authorization records (Online, Batch, Manual), Supportive Service Payment issuances are created via Payment Request authorization records and Auxiliary Issuances via Auxiliary Authorization records which does not require any eligibility determination.

The Auxiliary Issuance framework was introduced in CalSAWS with release 21.05 with an aim of introducing a flexible benefit issuance mechanism to CalSAWS that can be utilized to issue Water Pilot benefits and can be used in future for purposes beyond the initial Water Pilot implementation.

The correspondence related to CalFresh Water Pilot benefits are not available in the system. i.e., CF 304A - Important Information About Your CalFresh Benefits - CalFresh Water Pilot, CF 304B - Notice of Approval for the CalFresh Water Pilot and CF 304C - Notice of Discontinuance for the CalFresh Water Pilot.

1.2 Requests

1. This SCR will implement policy changes associated with ACL 20-97 under which CDSS has developed a state-funded pilot program to provide time-limited supplemental nutrition benefits to CalFresh households that meets the following criteria:
 - a. Reside within a disadvantaged community.

- b. Receive drinking water from a public water system that does not meet primary drinking water standards under the California safe drinking water Act.
- 2. Add the CF 304A - Important Information About Your CalFresh Benefits - CalFresh Water Pilot, CF 304B - Notice of Approval for the CalFresh Water Pilot, and CF 304C - Notice of Discontinuance for the CalFresh Water Pilot forms to CalSAWS.
- 3. Add logic to send CF 304C form when customer gets discontinued for CalFresh Water Pilot benefits.

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

- 1. Add a new EBT Benefit type, Pay Code and Discontinuance reasons for water Pilot.
- 2. Update Issuance Detail page to display the Pay Code field for issuances associated to the authorization type of Auxiliary Authorization.
- 3. Update EBT Repayment Detail page and EBT Expungement Reader Job to exclude Water Pilot issuances to restrict the user from applying water pilot benefits towards any existing CalFresh Overissuances.
- 4. Add a monthly Discontinuance batch module to discontinue the issuance of Water Pilot benefits if the CalFresh household is no longer eligible.
- 5. Update Claiming logic to correctly process and claim Water Pilot Issuances.
- 6. Add CF 304A - Important Information About Your CalFresh Benefits - CalFresh Water Pilot form in English and Spanish to CalSAWS.
- 7. Add CF 304B - Notice of Approval for the CalFresh Water Pilot form in English and Spanish to CalSAWS.
- 8. Add CF 304C - Notice of Discontinuance for the CalFresh Water Pilot form in English and Spanish to CalSAWS.
- 9. Add a monthly batch job to send the CF 304C form to the customers who are discontinued from CalFresh Water Pilot benefits.

1.4 Assumptions

- 1. The SCR CA-227819 will mass mail the CF 304A form which is the informing notice (22.01 release).
- 2. SCR CA-228715 is to identify the Safe Water Pilot Eligible population and to mail the CF 304B – Approval notice. This SCR will also include the one-time mass sweep of eligible records for Water Pilot benefits. Water Pilot eligibility is based on a household's physical address in one of the Water Pilot ZIP Codes: (93241 (Lamont),93220 (Edison),93243 (Gorman-Lebec),93311 (Bakersfield),93387 (Bakersfield),93386 (Bakersfield))
- 3. Water Pilot benefits are nutrition benefits which will be issued via EBT to the CalFresh Payee as Supplemental benefits. The CalFresh Payee will always be a person and not a resource.
- 4. Water Pilot benefits are subject to existing Electronic Benefit Transfer, or EBT, account aging and expungement rules.
- 5. Water Pilot Program expunged benefits will not be reactivated.
- 6. Water Pilot benefits are not eligible for EBT repayments.

Commented [IK2R1]: Since water pilot benefits will be issued via the Auxiliary Issuance framework, they follow the same rules for skip issuance. So they will show up on the skipped issuance report.

7. Water Pilot benefits are subject to available funding. In the event that the length of the pilot needs to be reduced due to insufficient funds, CDSS will provide CalSAWS a 60-day notice. This will be a separate SCR.
8. Water Pilot benefits must not be included in the benefit count for the purpose of federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program reporting (e.g., DFA 256).
9. Water Pilot benefits will be issued via automation for a period of 12 months using the Auxiliary Issuance framework as part of SCR CA-228715. The Auxiliary Issuance page can be used by the worker to manually issue or discontinue Pilot benefits. However, the worker must refrain from issuing these benefits prior to March 1, 2022.
10. Any overpayments will need to be created manually.
11. To be eligible for the Water Pilot program, the household must meet all Water Pilot eligibility requirements on the day of policy implementation.
12. Only Active CalFresh Households with a physical address in one of the eligible ZIP Codes are entitled to receive the Water Pilot benefits.
13. Pilot eligibility is based on a household's physical address. Household's that have their mailing address in a Water Pilot program eligible ZIP Code and a physical address outside of a pilot zip code are not eligible.
14. CalFresh households that move into a Water Pilot ZIP Code after the date of pilot implementation are not eligible. Furthermore, households receiving pilot benefits who move out of original Water Pilot ZIP Code are no longer eligible for Water Pilot benefits, even if the new residential ZIP Code is a Pilot eligible ZIP Code. If a household moves within the same ZIP Code, then they will continue to be eligible for the Water Pilot.
15. CalFresh households whose living arrangement is associated with an institution or group living indicator are not eligible.
16. If a household is initially approved for Water Pilot benefit and later gets discontinued after the date of implementation, then that household will lose the eligibility to receive any future Water Pilot benefits for the remaining period of the policy.
17. If a household eligible for Water Pilot benefit is discontinued after the date of implementation and benefits are later restored without break in aid, the household's pilot benefits will be automatically restored at the same time.
18. Households with a pending CalFresh application that is not approved on the date of implementation are not eligible.
19. Households receiving Transitional CalFresh (TCF) on the date of implementation are not eligible OR if a household which was approved for the Water Pilot benefit becomes TCF eligible during the pilot period, then it will no longer be considered as an active CalFresh program household for the purpose of the Water Pilot and will cease receiving Pilot benefits.
20. Households receiving Transitional Nutrition Benefits (TNB) on the date of implementation OR if a household becomes TNB-eligible during the pilot period, then it will no longer be considered as an active CalFresh program household for the purpose of Pilot and will cease receiving Pilot benefits.
21. Water Pilot benefits cannot be paid pending a hearing or an appeal decision. However, County Welfare Department (CWD) may issue a pilot supplement because of an appeal or hearing decision. The CWD must issue this supplement manually.

22. Water Pilot benefits are subject to existing EBT account aging and expungement rules. However, expunged Water Pilot benefits must not be reinstated/reactivated. Furthermore, expunged Water Pilot Benefits will not be used to repay towards an existing CalFresh recovery account.
23. The Pilot Benefit amount will be fixed for the duration of the Pilot and will apply irrespective of the CalFresh household size.
24. For Water Pilot issuances, no aid code and pay code adjustments will be allowed. Only Cancellations will be allowed via the Issuance detail page which would then be adjusted/claimed accordingly.
25. CF 304B and CF 304C forms will use the existing NA BACK9(04/2013).
26. When the CF 304C form is being generated from the Template Repository the discontinuance date and the discontinuance reason checkboxes will be blank if the CalFresh water pilot benefits were not previously discontinued.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 DBCR/CTCR Changes:

2.1.1 Overview

This section describes changes to add a new EBT Benefit type, a new Pay Code and new Discontinuance reasons for Water Pilot benefits.

2.1.2 Description of Change

1. Add New EBT Benefit type for Water Pilot as "CF01".
2. Add a new Pay code for Safe water Pilot Benefits – "CalFresh Safe Water Pilot Benefits"
 - a. This Pay Code will be available only for Kern County
 - b. This Pay Code will be mapped to CalFresh program
 - c. This Pay Code will be mapped as Non-Federal
3. Create the following new discontinuance reasons for why the auxiliary payment was discontinued. Insert new values in the code category for Auxiliary Payment Discontinuance Reason as follows:
 - a. household no longer receiving CalFresh benefits
 - b. household moved out of eligible ZIP Code.
 - c. household became eligible for Transitional CalFresh benefits
 - d. household became eligible for Transitional Nutrition benefits
 - e. CalFresh Water Pilot benefits ending (as come up month is February 2023)
 - f. household living in an institution or group living arrangement

2.2 Issuance Detail

2.2.1 Overview

The Issuance Detail page allows the user to view and edit the issuance details for a program and benefit month. In addition, this page also allows the user to replace EBT benefits.

2.2.2 Description of Changes

1. Update Issuance Detail page to display the Pay Code field for issuances associated to the authorization type of Auxiliary Authorization.
2. Update the Issuance Detail page to assign 'CalFresh Safe Water Pilot Benefits' as Pay Code for any replacements/reissue of Water Pilot Issuance.

Note: The Pay code field on the Issuance Detail page will be Read-Only for CalFresh Water Pilot benefit issuances, and their Reissue/Replacements.

2.3 EBT Food Writer Interface

1. Update the daily Food EBT interface to map the Water Pilot issuances to the EBT benefit type of CF01.
2. Conduct Interface file testing for the new EBT Benefit type.
3. Conduct EBT H2H testing with EBT vendor for the new EBT Benefit type.

2.3.8 Description of Changes

1. This process will set the Payment Amount for Water Pilot Issuances and will be claimed as Non-Federal benefits based on Pay code – CalFresh Safe Water Pilot benefits.

2.4 New Monthly Water Pilot Discontinuance Sweep

2.4.1 Overview

If a household loses eligibility for receiving the Safe Water Pilot Benefit, a timely and adequate pilot discontinuance NOA will be provided to the household informing them about the discontinuance. This update is to introduce a new Discontinuance job in the system that will scan all approved Auxiliary Authorization records for Safe Water Pilot that will lose their eligibility for receiving Pilot benefits.

2.4.2 Description of Change

1. Identify all approved Auxiliary Authorization records for the Safe Water Pilot that may become ineligible to receive pilot benefits for the upcoming month if any of the following criteria is met:
 - i. The participant is no longer active or a recipient on CalFresh.
 - ii. Participant moved out of eligible ZIP Code.
 - iii. Participant became eligible for Transitional CalFresh benefits
