### Memorandum Purpose:

This memorandum is intended to convey the batch EDBC scope, county actions and schedule for the referenced program changes.

### Scope:

Per ACL 21-76, SCR CA-219844/CIV-107958 will implement Foster Care/Kin-GAP CNI COLA on 08/20/2021.

Per ACL 21-XX, SCR CA-219846 will implement the AAP CNI COLA on 08/20/2021.

Per ACL 21-92, SCR CA-220108/CIV-108000 will implement the CalWORKs Tier 1 and Tier 2 IRT increase on 09/09/2021.

Per ACL 21-87, SCR CA-220108/CIV-108000 will implement the CalWORKs MAP increase on 09/09/2021.

Per ACIN I-XX-21 and Nutrition Service SNAP COLA Memo FY 2021, SCR CA-220108/CIV-108000 will implement the CalFresh COLA on 09/09/2021.

Per ACL 21-XX, SCR CA-230979/CIV-109238 will implement the new TNB/SNB benefit amount increase on 09/09/2021.

To minimize the work required by the counties, the project will take the following actions over the weekend:

### Foster Care/Kin-GAP/AAP Batch EDBC Processing on 09/11/2021:

1. **Batch for Foster Care (FC), Kin-Gap (KG) and Adoption Assistance Program (AAP)**  
Run batch EDBC for all cases with active Foster Care (FC) and Kin-Gap (KG) programs in both systems and cases with an active Adoption Assistance Program (AAP) program for CalSAWS only.

Batch EDBC will include all cases with FC, KG and AAP programs that are active for the benefit month of 07/2021 or later, unless they meet the exception criteria below, and run

EDBC for the benefit months of 07/2021, 08/2021, 09/2021 and 10/2021 to apply the new values:

- a. Programs will not be run if a Non-standard rate is in effect in the benefit month.
- b. Programs will not be run if there is an overridden aid code where a sub type code exists.
- c. Existing batch logic in both systems will skip programs with an overridden EDBC, Manual EDBC, a pending program, or a pending person.
- d. In CalSAWS: Per existing exception logic, on programs where the existing EDBC for the month is Read-Only, batch EDBC results will not be authorized.  
In C-IV: these will result in Read-Only EDBCs.
- e. In CalSAWS: run the above population with Run Reason 'CWS Annual COLA' (CT744\_DC).
- f. In C-IV: the online pre-EDBC validation criteria will prevent Foster Care programs from being run. For these cases, a placement authority and at least one child placement must exist for the benefit month. Exclude any cases that meet the exception criteria below:
  - i. There is a Non-Related Legal Guardianship placement authority month with a Probate court established guardianship and the rate level is set to a value other than Schedule A, Schedule B, Age-Based or Basic
  - ii. There is a Non-Related Legal Guardianship placement authority with a Juvenile court established guardianship and the rate level is set to a value other than Schedule A, Schedule B, Age-Based, Basic, LOC 2, LOC 3, or LOC4
  - iii. There is an ISFC rate with no Approved or Licensed ISFC License for the duration of the rate within the placement and benefit month.
  - iv. There is a STRTP rate with no Approved or Licensed STRTP License for the duration of the rate within the placement and benefit month.
  - v. There is an FFA, FFA Treatment, FFA Intensive Programs, Multidimensional Treatment, or FFA Non-Treatment placement with a 'County or FFA ISFC' Standard State Rate and no ISFC State Program Number.

## 2. NOAs:

- a. All notices will be sent to the Central Printing facility the night of the batch EDBC process.
- b. Regulations and reason text for FC/KG COLA NOA will be updated for FY 2021-22 COLA.

CalSAWS only:

- a. Age Increase NOAs will be suppressed during KG COLA Run.
- b. Last year's ACL reference (ACL No. 20-68) has been removed from the regulations on the AAP COLA NOA as the updated ACL number was not received in time to make the update.
- c. FC/KG/AAP COLA NOAs will be mailed on 9/22/2021 as that is when the warrants will be mailed.

### 3. Journal:

CalSAWS only:

A Journal entry will be created for FC/KG/AAP programs run by the batch EDBC process.

- a. Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for {Benefit Month}.
- b. Long Description: Batch EDBC ran for {Benefit Month}. Batch EDBC processed for the {Program Code} program for following reasons: {Program} COLA.

C-IV only:

A Journal entry will be created with the following information for each case processed through the one-time batch process. There will be only one journal per case, per benefit month successfully processed.

- a. Journal Category: Eligibility
- b. Journal Type: Batch EDBC
- c. Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].
- d. Long Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR]. Batch EDBC processed for the [Program Type] for the following reasons: 2021 FC CNI Increase

**CalWORKs MAP, Tier1 and Tier 2 IRT, CalFresh COLA and TNB/SNB Benefit Increase Batch EDBC Processing on 09/11/2021:**

**1. Batch:**

- a. Run batch EDBC on 9/11/2021 for the benefit month of 10/2021 for:
  - i. All cases with an active or ineligible CalWORKs or RCA program in targeted program mode. Targeting program mode will include CF programs on the CW/CF combo cases.  
Exclude the following cases:
    1. The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
    2. The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 09/2021, and the report status is Sent, Received, or Incomplete.
    3. A regular EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-220108/CIV-108000 went to production on 9/09/2021.
  - ii. In CalSAWS: run the above population with Run Reason 'CW/CF COLA' (CT744\_CF).
  - iii. In CalSAWS: run the above population with Sub Type code 'CW/CF COLA' (CT942\_C1)
- b. Run batch EDBC on 9/11/2021 for the benefit month of 10/2021 for:
  - i. All active or ineligible CF (including TCF) programs in single program mode.  
Exclude the following cases:
    1. The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
    2. The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 09/2021, and the report status is Sent, Received, or Incomplete.
    3. EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-220108/CIV-108000 went to production on 9/09/2021

- ii. In CalSAWS: Run the above population with run reason 'CF COLA' (CT744\_FS).
- iii. In CalSAWS: Run the above population with Sub Type code 'CF COLA' (CT942\_C3).

NOTE: Batch shall process recommendation b. only after the completion of recommendation a. This is to ensure that an active CalFresh program with household members active on a different CalWORKs case gets processed accurately.

- c. In CalSAWS: Run batch EDBC on 9/11/2021 for the benefit month of 10/2021 for:
  - i. All active or ineligible Nutrition Benefit (TNB and SNB) programs in single program mode.  
Exclude the following cases:
    - 1. The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the TNB program.
    - 2. EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-230979/CIV-109238 went to production on 9/09/2021.
  - ii. In CalSAWS: Run the above population with Sub Type code 'SNB/TNB Benefit Change' (CT942\_N1).

NOTE: Batch shall process recommendation c. only after the completion of recommendation b. This is to ensure that all active SNB and TNB programs get processed accurately.

## 2. NOAs:

In CalSAWS: DCR will update the SAR 2 Effective month as high dated EDBC month i.e., October 2021 (in SYS\_TRANSACT table) to populate the latest IRT limit in SAR 2 form for the cases run with 'CW/CF COLA' or 'CF COLA' run reason.

All notices will be sent to the Central Printing facility the night of the batch EDBC process.

## 3. Journal:

In CalSAWS: A journal entry will be created for each program run by the batch EDBC process. This will be the standard journal entry added by the batch EDBC process. The long description will read:

- a. CW/CF COLA:  
"Batch EDBC Ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <Program Name> program for following reasons: 'CW/CF COLA'"
- b. CF COLA:  
"Batch EDBC Ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <Program Name> program for following reasons: 'CF COLA'"
- c. SNB/TNB Benefit Change:

“Batch EDBC Ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <Program Name> program for following reasons: ‘SNB/TNB Benefit Change’

4. In C-IV: A standard journal will be created by a data change request to insert a journal with the following information for each case processed through the one-time batch process. The description will read:
  - a. Journal Category: Eligibility  
Journal Type: Batch EDBC  
Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].  
Long Description: Batch EDBC ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <program> program for following reasons: ‘CW/CF COLA’.
  - b. Journal Category: Eligibility  
Journal Type: Batch EDBC  
Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].  
Long Description: Batch EDBC ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <program> program for following reasons: ‘CF COLA’.
  - c. Journal Category: Eligibility  
Journal Type: Batch EDBC  
Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].  
Long Description: Batch EDBC ran for <Effective Month, Year>. Batch EDBC processed for the <program> program for following reasons: ‘SNB/TNB Benefit Change’.

1. Deliver the FC/KG/AAP/ driving query and list queries to the System Test team on 08/18/2021.
2. Deliver the CW/CF/NB driving query and list queries to the System Test team on 08/24/2021.
3. System Testing of the FC/KG/AAP/ batch process will occur between 08/19/2021 and 09/10/2021.
4. System Testing of the CW/CF/NB batch process will occur between 08/25/2021 and 09/10/2021.
5. Run FC/KG/AAP/CW/CF/NB batch EDBC in production for both systems on 09/11/2021.
6. CalSAWS Only: There is a limitation of 16K unique cases in each file that is sent to eCAPS. Based on the case count, the number of COLA files will be determined.
7. CalSAWS Only: Auditor Controller, eCAPS process, Warrant Print/Issue, EFT Settlement and Mail Dates are given below:

**Things to remember about these batch EDBC processes:**

- All impacts from Defects and SCRs which have not been implemented will continue to occur during the batch processing.
- There are multiple reasons why a program may not be successfully run through batch EDBC processing. Some examples include: No Worker Assigned, Overridden Program Case, and Pending Program/ Person/ Application. Please review tasks and the Batch Eligibility Report daily.
- The EDBCs will have an EDBC Source of 'Batch EDBC Rules'.
- When a user runs EDBC on a case where a prior pending month exists, the EDBC will have a type of Read-Only. When running Batch EDBC that restriction does not apply and these EDBCs will not be Read-Only.
- Any updates or lack of updates made/ not made to cases will impact the Batch EDBC results. This means programs may be discontinued (due to non-compliances, etc.) unexpectedly.
- All notices will be generated normally.
  - Note: As mentioned in the NOA's section of the FC/KG/AAP COLA run above, the FC/KG/AAP COLA NOAs will be released on 9/22/2021.

**County Action:**

- Review cases included in the lists and take necessary action.
- Review the Batch Eligibility Report and action cases which could not be processed. This report is an on-request report available under Global: Reports > Local: On Request > Task: Administrative. If you do not see this report, please contact your Security

- CalSAWS will not be down during batch processing on Saturday, September 11, 2021
- Batch jobs scheduled for each evening will run after the batch EDBC process completes.
- Approximately 80,000 active programs will be processed during the FC/KG batch EDBC process in C-IV for the benefit months of 07/2021 - 10/2021.
- Approximately 200,000 active programs will be processed during the FC/KG/AAP batch EDBC process in CalSAWS for the benefit month of 07/2021 - 10/2021.
- Approximately 583,000 active programs will be processed during the CW/CF batch EDBC process in C-IV for the benefit month of 10/2021.
- Approximately 715,000 active programs will be processed during the CW/CF batch EDBC process in CalSAWS for the benefit month of 10/2021.
- Approximately 50,000 programs processed per hour via batch EDBC.
