The one-time batch EDBC run details related to the CNI COLA Rate increase for FC/KG programs can be found in SCR CA-219849.</p> <p>CA-219846- updated the new increased AAP CNI rate for Fiscal Year 2021-22 for AAP program effective July 1, 2021. The one-time batch EDBC run details related to the CNI COLA Rate increase for AAP program can be found under SCR CA-219851.</p>
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CA-220108/CIV-108000 updated the CalFresh COLA levels for FFY 2021-2022 and CalWORKs MAP and IRT for Tier 1 and Tier 2 levels effective October 1, 2021. CA-220108/CIV-108000 was implemented with minor release 21.09.09 on September 9, 2021.

Note: CA-220109/CIV-108001 which will run batch and apply the COLA values for CalFresh and CalWORKs MAP/IRT, the Nutritional Benefits COLA, as well as CNI for Foster Care/Kin-GAP/AAP programs, was implemented September 11, 2021.
