**Change Notice Number Four**

THE AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT FOR QA SERVICES FOR LRS PROJECT (“AGREEMENT”) ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CALSAWS CONSORTIUM (“CONSORTIUM”), A CALIFORNIA JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY, AND FIRST DATA GOVERNMENT SOLUTIONS, LP (“CONTRACTOR”) FOR PROVISION OF THE CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE AUTOMATED WELFARE SYSTEM (“CalSAWS”).

Pursuant to Section 4.6 (Professional Services) and 4.7 (Service Request) of the Agreement, Consortium and First Data agree to add the following Professional Services to Exhibit A – Statement of Work of the Agreement, and request funding for those additional Professional Services from already allocated funds as follows:

1. Consortium has allotted funding that may be used toward future work for Professional Services when the allocation for which is approved by the Consortium Executive Director and Contractor’s Project Manager or their respective designees.
2. This Change Notice Number Four requests One Hundred Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$116,928) to be used for Professional Services for State Fiscal Year 2021/22 to provide Testing Staff Augmentation. The estimated effort, price, and assumptions are set forth in Attachment 1 (Testing Staff Augmentation). Professional Services charges and invoicing related to Testing Staff Augmentation will be invoiced on a Time and Materials basis in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$116,928).
3. Subsequent to the final approval of this Change Notice Four, the balance remaining from the Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) Professional Services approved in LRS Amendment 5 and the Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) Professional Services approved in LRS Amendment 7, but unallocated, funds for future work will be Five Hundred and Four Thousand Four Hundred and Forty-Eight Dollars (\$504,448).

This Change Notice Number Four shall be effective upon execution by Consortium and First Data.

Except as provided in Change Notice Number Four, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
